Cadets open the state tourney against Mayo

Saint Thomas Academy (10-0) captured the Section 3 title to earn a berth in the state Class AAAAA tournament. STA will play Rochester-Mayo in the

first round of state at noon Saturday, November 8, at Woodbury High School.

The Cadets qualified for state by defeating Two Rivers, 32-19, on Halloween. Saint Thomas had beaten Two Rivers 50-14 during the regular season.

A touchdown run by the Cadets junior quarterback Tristan Karl, and two TDs by senior running back Todd Rogalski got it started against the Warriors. Rogalski first scored on a pick-six from his defensive back position, then caught a 33-yard pass from Karl for another TD. STA’s final TD came on a fumble recovery and run by senior defensive lineman Teddy Petschel. Junior kicker Loren Piltingsrud booted two extra points and added a field goal.

Down 32-0, the Warriors scored the final 19 points of the game, but had dug themselves to deep of a hole.

Saint Thomas enters the state Class AAAAA tournament with victories this season over three other teams in the eight-team tourney, including Rochester-Mayo (by a score of 17-12), CDH (27-14) and Chanhassen (28-14).

Description of Area C
"Area C" refers to the name given to Ford Motor Company's former industrial waste dump on the floodplain of the Mississippi River at the base of the bluff below the former Twin Cities Assembly Plant in Saint Paul. From approximately 1945 through the mid-1960s, Ford disposed of paint sludge and solvents used in automobile painting operations at the base of the bluff. Ford also disposed of construction rubble, contaminated soil, scrap metal, and other types of debris at Area C.

During the reconstruction of Lock & Dam No. 1 in the late 1970s and early 1980s, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers disposed of a large volume of construction rubble and sand on top of and surrounding the industrial waste. The city of Saint Paul placed additional rubble at Area C during reconstruction of the Mississippi River Boulevard in the late 1980s. Up to 60 feet of soil and debris covers the majority of the industrial waste, which is overlain by a paved parking lot.

MPCA Decision
The MPCA seeks public input on the cleanup alternatives described in the Feasibility Study. After the end of the public comment period, the MPCA will choose a cleanup plan for Area C, to be implemented by Ford Motor Company.**Community informational meeting**
A community meeting gives interested persons an opportunity to ask questions concerning the proposed project. MPCA staff will be present to provide information about the history and environmental conditions at Area C and the proposed cleanup alternatives described in the Feasibility Study. The community meeting will be held in January 2026 (evening), at a location and date to be determined.**Submitting Comments**
