# Description of Area C

"Area C" refers to the name given to Ford Motor Company's former industrial waste dump on the floodplain of the Mississippi River at the base of the bluff below the former Twin Cities Assembly Plant in Saint Paul. From approximately 1945 through the mid-1960s, Ford disposed of paint sludge and solvents used in automobile painting operations at the base of the bluff. Ford also disposed of construction rubble, contaminated soil, scrap metal, and other types of debris at Area C.

During the reconstruction of Lock & Dam No. 1 in the late 1970s and early 1980s, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers disposed of a rubble at Area C during reconstruction of the Mississippi River Boulevard in the late 1980s. Up to 60 feet of soil and debris covers the majority of the industrial waste, which is overlain by a paved parking lot.
