WASHINGTON (AP) — For their own glorification, Julius Caesar and the emperor Augustus each swiped a day from February. Now if someone had heisted Feb. 29, Uncle Sam would save \$115 million today.

That's how much the government pays its employes for working one extra day every four years.

Aha, you say. Most civil servants have an annual salary. You're wrong. The salary is based on a 52-week year. In an ordinary year they're paid 52 weeks and one day. This year, it's 52 weeks and two days. Another day, another \$115 million. But next fiscal year the government recoups. July 1, the first day, is a Saturday. June 30 next year, the last day, is a Saturday. Fifty-two even. No overrun.

That windfall will be the first two-day drop in what the gov-ernment calls "compensable days" since the present system was adopted 25 years ago. It won't happen again until the fiscal year 2001—because July 1, 1999, to June 30, 2000, will have the two extra days and the following year none.

Now Caesar and Augustus didn't have savings in mind when they robbed February. When Romulus made the first

Roman calendar he didn't even

have February among his 10 months. His successor, Numa Pompilius, added two months but he tacked February onto the end of the year. The name Februarius came from a Latin word meaning "to purify" be-cause it was then the Romans cleansed themselves to prepare for New Year festivals.

Along came Julius Caesar. He plucked out February and put it between January and March. But for such exaltation he exacted a price-one of its 30 days—which he added to July, named for guess who. Not to be outdone, Augustus

also clipped off a day and added it to his month.
