
Scott Eaton has more than 17 years of service with Newburyport Five Cents Savings Bank, presently serving as a senior vice president. He

Owner and Realtor, 1 NORTH at Keller Williams Realty


A lifelong Newburyport resident, Byron Lane spent nine years in law enforcement before shifting gears





Sean Stellmach entered the fitness field with a Bachelor of Science in community health education and a National Academy of Sports Medicine Personal Training Certifi-




life. She met her husband and bought her first home here, and says she is honored to have been touched and influenced by so many of the amazing people who have also made this community their home.





President, Arthur S. Page Insurance


Jackie Page began working at Arthur S. Page Insurance





ASHLEY BUSH


Owner/Operator, Buttermilk Baking Company
