Ruth Sharrer Hahn, age 103, of Lebanon Twp., NJ passed away on Wednesday, November 17, 2021 at Little Brook Nursing Home in Califon, NJ.

She was born on March 18, 1918 in a farm house in Lebanon, Twp., NJ. Ruth was a lifelong resident of Lebanon Twp. and resided for her entire life on the same family property where she was born. She was the daughter of the late Eugene and Olive Hoffman Sharrer. On her mother's side her ancestry can be traced to the 1600's in Lebanon Township and most notably to John Fisher, who donated the land for the Mount Lebanon Church (former Mt. Lebanon Grange Hall).

Ruth was a graduate of High Bridge High School. She married George F. Hahn in 1940. She and her husband were dairy farmers.
