## RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON AUTHORIZING THE RETURN OF 2025 PROPERTY TAXES AND THE CANCELATION OF REMAINING TAXES FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2025 AND 2026

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 54:5-3.30, exempts disabled veterans from paying real property taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-32, the governing body of a municipality may by resolution cancel and return the taxes due on a property that would have been exempt from taxation had the claim been made at the time the tax was levied; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Veteran's Administration ("VA") has issued a determination that the owners of Block 12 Lot 10.05 are veterans who have suffered a 100% service-related disability; and

WHEREAS, the VA's determination, and the property's exemption from real property taxes, is retroactive to July 11, 2025; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to issue a refund for taxes from July 11, 2025, through December 31, 2026.
