ORDINANCE #1221-2026

ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$1,950,000, INCLUDING \$1,857,100 OF PROCEEDS OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES AND \$92,900 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND, IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that the \$1,950,000 originally appropriated pursuant to Section 3(a)(i) of Bond Ordinance #1094-16 of the Township of Clinton, in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey (the “Township”), finally adopted October 26, 2016, including \$1,857,100 of the proceeds of obligations issued pursuant to such bond ordinance and the \$92,900 appropriated as the down payment from the Capital Improvement Fund, is no longer necessary for the construction of a new maintenance facility and related improvements thereto.

Section 2. The \$1,950,000 appropriation described in Section 1 and made available pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39 is hereby reappropriated to provide for (i) HVAC and building upgrades to the Public Safety Building and Fire Stations in the amount of \$450,000, and (ii) roadway and infrastructure, including storm catch basin and curb repairs and other improvements in the amount of \$1,500,000, each including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Section 3. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
