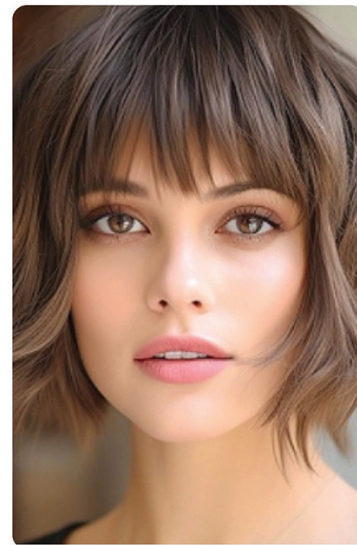

The former Bayberry Antiques is now the Big Green Barn, which features a trove of vintage and antique décor, all curated by Bush, who is the home and garden editor of New Jersey Monthly magazine.

“I’m delighted that local shoppers have embraced my Morris County store,” Bush says. “After writing and styling for the magazine for more than a decade, working for Sotheby’s fine art auction house and studying at the New York School of Interior Design, I took the plunge to open my local retail location with encouragement from my husband Robert, who is originally from Bernardsville.”

Harding Township’s shopping district is experiencing a revitalization as several new businesses have opened their doors along the stretch of Mount Kemble Avenue/Route 202, known for decades as the “Old Country Mile.”

For All Your Holiday Celebrations

Champagne, and sparkling wines, are some of the most celebratory beverages on earth. Just the simple act of popping the cork on a bottle, whether it is a value priced Cava from Spain or a great old vintage from its namesake region in France, always seems to make the moment that much more festive. Versatile and food friendly, these wines are the perfect starter to a great meal, wonderful with a wide range of appetizers, and with the right menu can work delightfully throughout a dinner.

Champagne, after all, is wine, yet not all that bubbles is Champagne. So, what sets these special wines apart from the rest of the sparkling wines in the world? The first is what the French call *terroir*, a term that encompasses all the elements of climate, soil, exposure, and sun that affect how grapes ripen in a specific region or vineyard. True Champagne must come from the region of the same name. It is one of the most northerly wine regions in the world—if it were in North America, it would be on the same latitude, the 49th parallel, as Winnipeg, Canada.

The region's cool climate means that

the grapes are naturally tart and very high in acidity at harvest. The vineyards are mainly on gentle slopes composed of layers of tertiary soils a few feet deep (washed down over millions of years from the Isle de France, a geological formation that stretches west to the English Channel overlying deep chalk sub-soils). The combination of the cool climate and the geology of the region are in large part responsible for Champagne's inimitable crisp, complex, racy character.

The second factor is the grapes: Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, and Pinot Meunier are the major permitted varieties. The cool climate allows for a long ripening with much lower sugars and higher acidities, in fact so much so that ordinary still wine made here is often so tart that it is actually unpleasant to drink.

Enter the third factor, the method of fermentation, the *Methode Champenoise*. The magic of Champagne, the bubbles being the most obvious, is created when the wines go through a second fermentation in the bottle, a labor intensive and time-consuming process that is required for all true

Champagne. Less expensive bubblyies are often made in stainless steel for their secondary fermentation—a far less labor intensive and costly process, with a little trade off in quality.

In the world of Champagne, the big brands dominate the market, offering mostly good solid quality, but the buzz in the trade is all about small grower, estate grown and bottled wines. These boutique properties often sell for the same or less than the big brands and offer wonderful pure expressions of the villages and sub regions where they are grown, rather than the “house style” of the big brands.

A “best buy” small grower Champagnes include Ployez-Jacquemart Marie Weiss Brut, \$38, and Grongnet Blanc de Blancs Brut, \$40, both delivering classic Champagne character at a great price.

Wine Pairings



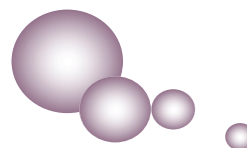
Step it up for special occasions to Billecart Salmon Brut Rosé, \$90, Vilmar & Cie Champagne Premier Cru Grand Cellier d'Or 2017, \$90, or some truly rare and fine top tier Champagnes from the very best producers. Agravart (low \$200s to \$400), Jacques Selosse (\$500+), Pierre Peters (\$65-\$500), Agravart (\$65-\$300), Dhondt Grellet (\$70-\$400), and Egly Ouriet (\$80 - \$500+) are all producing truly outstanding wines.

There are also sparkling wines made all over the world that are far less expensive than those from the Champagne region—but be careful—not all rise to the occasion. Crémant, made in the Champagne Methode from regions such as Burgundy, Bruno Danguin Crémant de Bourgogne "Cuvee Blanche," \$28, and Cave de Bissey's Crémant de Bourgogne Brut and Brut Rosé, both \$28, are delicious and affordable Champagne alternatives.



Cava from Spain can be terrific—look for smaller growers like Bertha's Cava Brut Nature 2019, \$15—clean, dry, and refreshing with fine bubbles. The same goes for Prosecco—great choices include Bele Casal from northern Italy, \$18, or Bisol Crede, \$20, or a fantastic dry sparkling Ettore Germano Rosanna, \$30, made from the Nebbiolo grapes in the Barolo region.

This holiday season make it a point to add a little sparkle to your life—but don't forget about the rest of the year! A little bubbly will make even life's simple moments that much more special—Cheers!

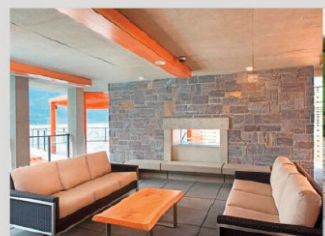

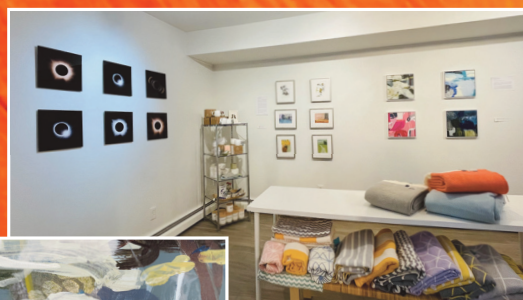

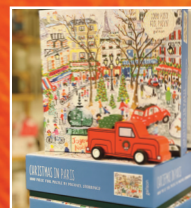

Tis the season to celebrate with family and friends. If yours is the holiday house, consider surprising guests with an updated twist on a childhood favorite. A DIY Hot Chocolate Bar with homemade hot cocoa and toppings will be a hit with kids and grown-ups. A hit-the-sweet-spot-station is more than warm and cozy; it's fun and games. Deck the Halls

Be My Guest

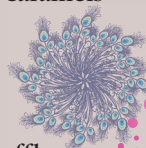
Choose toppings with guests in mind. Though it's easy to think the more the

Beautiful Bubble Baths Ideas to “Soak Away Holiday Stress”

The theory that soaking in warm water reduces stress, improves circulation, reduces pain, eases fatigue, and boosts mood is more than anecdotal. A study cited by the National Institute of Health reports that immersion bathing in warm water induces vasodilation—the widening of blood vessels resulting in enhanced blood flow to areas of the body lacking oxygen and nutrients. The study showed “significantly better general health, mental health, role emotional, and social functioning scores.” Taking a bath is a scientifically proven way to benefit physical and emotional health.

Start with Structure

Step into a soaking tub for full-body immersion. Longer and deeper than bathtubs which hold 25 to 45 gallons of water, soaking tubs can hold up to 250 gallons. Their water depth typically measures 3 feet versus 1 foot in a bathtub. Alcove soaking tubs are surrounded by walls on three sides. Corner vessels come in triangular or wedge shapes. Drop-in tubs are installed into custom-

designed, raised units, and freestanding tubs in oval or rectangular shapes aren't attached to walls or floors. Whichever type fits best, questions to consider are: does the tub need an overflow drain, will the water heater accommodate the gallons needed to fill it, are plumbing connections adequate, and are the floor and supports in good enough condition to hold the weight of tub and water?

Infuse Aromatics

Pour bubble bath, bath bombs, Epsom salts or Dead Sea salts under the tub faucet to infuse air and water with scents and softeners. Bath products free of artificial fragrances or dyes include natural plant oils and essential oils. Test for skin sensitivity prior to using natural oils such as sweet almond, apricot kernel, jojoba, and olive oil or essential oils like lavender, sandalwood, neroli, chamomile, rose otto, Virginia cedarwood, and geranium. Dilute essential oils by adding 6-8 drops to a tablespoon of natural oil before running under a faucet. Both Epsom salts, which was named for the English town

of Epsom where the salts were first discovered, and Dead Sea salts, minerals found only in the Dead Sea in the Middle East, are known to calm symptoms of psoriasis, eczema, and various types of arthritis. Luxuriate in water that's ideally between 100°F-110°F for 15-30 minutes. After a bath, lock in hydration with body butters made up of shea, cocoa, mango, and coconut oil for maximum moisturization.

Enrich Relaxation

Improve the ambience of a bath with tub-specific products. Inflatable pillows for head and neck and full-body cushions make soaking more comfortable. Waterproof speakers pipe in relaxing music, and portable spa bubble baths add a Jacuzzi effect. If the tub is freestanding, a stool eases getting in and out, and caddies feature places for books, phones, soaps, candles, and even holders for stemmed wineglasses. Cushiony bathmats and thick towels required! To create a spa experience at home, think set-up, senses, and accessories.

Table to Tub — Pantry Ingredients to Add to Your Bath

- Baking Soda neutralizes the pH of an infected area and reduces itching.
- Cinnamon Sticks enhance scent and reduce inflammation.
- Coconut Milk smooths and hydrates skin.
- Ginger stimulates blood flow and reduces muscle aches.
- Green Tea reduces muscle pain and softens skin.
- Herbs like eucalyptus, tea tree oil, rosemary, and lavender deepen breathing, elevate mood, and promote relaxation.
- Milk gently exfoliates skin.
- Oats soothe dry, itchy skin and reduce inflammation.
- Sake exfoliates skin and promotes healthy complexion.

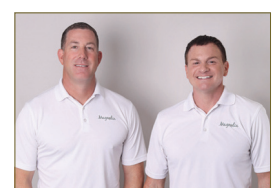
