WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act; N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq., declares it to be the public policy of the State to ensure the right of citizens to have adequate advance notice of and the right to attend meetings of public bodies at which business affecting the public is discussed or acted upon; and

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act also recognizes exceptions to the right of the public to attend portions of such meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee find it necessary to conduct an executive session closed to the public as permitted by the N.J.S.A. 40:4-12; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Committee will reconvene in public session at the conclusion of the executive session;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Lebanon, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey that they will conduct an executive session to discuss the following topic(s) as permitted by N.J.S.A. 40:4-12:

A matter which Federal Law, State Statute or Rule of Court requires be kept confidential or excluded from discussion in public (Provision relied upon: _____);

A matter where the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the federal government;

A matter whose disclosure would constitute an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy;

A collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions thereof.

A matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of bank rates or investment of public funds where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed;

Tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public provided that their disclosure could impair such protection;

Investigations of violations or possible violations of the law, _____;

Pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is or may become a party; (The general nature of the litigation or contract negotiations is): Statewide Insurance Fund. The public disclosure of such information at this time would have a potentially negative impact on the municipality's position in the litigation or negotiation; therefore this

information will be withheld until such time as the matter is concluded or the potential for negative impact no longer exists.);

Matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his or her ethical duties as a lawyer; (Public disclosure of such information at this time would have a potentially negative impact on the municipality's position with respect to the matter being discussed; therefore this information will be withheld until such time as the matter is concluded or the potential for negative impact no longer exists.);

Matters involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance, promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective or current public officer or employee of the public body, where all individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected have not requested in writing that the matter(s) be discussed at a public meeting; the employee(s) and/or general nature of discussion is: unemployment, disciplinary action. And whereas the public disclosure of such information at this time would violate the employee(s) privacy rights; therefore, this information will be withheld until such time as the matter is concluded or the threat to privacy rights no longer exists;

Deliberation occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty or loss of a license or permit.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Committee hereby declare that their discussion of the subject(s) identified above may be made public at a time when the Township Attorney advises them that the disclosure of the discussion will not detrimentally affect any right, interest or duty of the Township or any other entity with respect to said discussion.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Committee, for the reasons set forth above, hereby declare that the public is excluded from the portion of the meeting during which the above discussion shall take place.

**APPOINTMENT OF CLASS III SPECIAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FOR THE

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:14A-146.8 et seq. entitled “Special Law Enforcement Officers’ Act” (hereinafter the “Act”) permits a municipality to appoint special law enforcement officers sufficient to perform the duties and responsibilities permitted by local ordinance authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, and within the conditions and limitations as may be established pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act, the Township Committee of the Township of Lebanon adopted Ordinance No. 2023-04 that establishing Chapter 77 of the Township Code, entitled “Police Department”; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.14 and Township Code §77-6 (A) permits the Township Committee to appoint from time to time, special law enforcement officers for a term not to exceed one year; and

WHEREAS, the Township Salary Ordinance provides for the rate of compensation for certain officers, employees and appointees of the Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.14 and Township Code §77-6 (A), the Township Committee desires to appoint certain individuals as Class III Special Law Enforcement Officers for a term not to exceed one year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lebanon, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey that the following individuals are hereby appointed for their respective terms, as follows:

Special Law Enforcement Officer, Class III – Gerard Clyne
Special Law Enforcement Officer, Class III – Douglas Moyle
Special Law Enforcement Officer, Class III – Timothy Hale
Special Law Enforcement Officer, Class III – Thomas Hash, Jr.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each of the Special Law Enforcement Officers appointed herein shall be appointed for a six (6) month term effective January 1, 2026 and terminating June 30, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above-named positions shall be compensated at the rate of \$40 per hour in accordance with the Township Salary Ordinance and Salary Resolution.
