Pursuant to Section 67-5-508, Tennessee Code Annotated, the property assessment records of Cocke County will be available for public inspection at Room 112, Cocke County Courthouse during the normal business hours. Any person desiring to inspect these records may do so at the appointed time and place.

The Cocke County Board of Equalization will begin its annual session to examine and equalize the county assessments on June 1, 2026. THE BOARD WILL ACCEPT APPEALS FOR TAX YEAR 2026 ONLY UNTIL THE LAST DAY OF ITS 2026 REGULAR SESSION, WHICH WILL BE June 18, 2026. The Board will meet Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. And Wednesday from the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at Newport City Hall.

Any owner of property who wishes to make a complaint or appeal to the County Board of Equalization must appear before said Board at this time personally or by personal appearance of an agent for the owner bearing the owner's written authorization. Failure to appear and appeal an assessment will result in the assessment becoming final without further right of appeal. The meetings are by appointment only.
