Narrative:

On April 29, 2025, at approximately 1158 hours, I was dispatched to 101 Courthouse (Transportation Center) in reference to a commercial burglary.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with Open Space Officer Juan Luna. Officer Luna advised he was notified by Dasha (a state representative assistant) on 4/17/25 that all three computers were located inside Room 231 on the desk. When Dasha arrived at the office today (4/29/25) at approximately 1038 hours, she noticed that all three HP silver laptops were missing.

Officer Luna reviewed the camera footage from 4/17/25 to 4/29/25. On Friday, 4/18/25, at approximately 1100 hours, a white Crown Victoria dropped off a male wearing a brown long-sleeve shirt, blue jeans, and a black hat with a "B" on it. The male entered through the unlocked south side doors. He walked around the first floor, pulling on the handles of office doors to check if they were open. All of the downstairs doors were locked and secured.

The male then walked upstairs and opened the door to Office Room 231. He remained in the room for approximately two minutes and exited at approximately 1120 hours carrying a black computer bag containing the three HP laptops. He then exited through the north doors and sat on a bench on the west side of the building, waiting for the train to arrive. Once the train arrived at 1510 hours, the male entered the train to go south bound.

Let it be noted that the night prior 4/17/25 there was a power outage for the building. The power came back on at approximately 0630 hours on 4/18/25. It is unknown if the power outage could have been a contributing factor to the automatic locking doors. During this time there were no employees or personnel in the building due to it being a holiday.

The Serial numbers were provided for each HP Elite Book. There serial numbers were provided to Central dispatch which was turned into dispatch and entered into NCIC as stolen.

Officer Luna emailed me the camera footage of the incident. The footage will be transferred to a thumb drive and tagged into evidence.

No charges will be filed at this time due to the male not being identified.

Nothing further to report at this time.
