The last day to register to vote in person or by mail postmarked for the August 6, 2026 Election is **July 7, 2026**. **The voter must be a registered voter in the city limits of Lenoir City to participate in the Lenoir City School Board Election.**

PHOTO ID REQUIRED FOR VOTERS:

If you are voting in person during Early Voting or on Election Day, a Federal or State of Tennessee Government issued **photo ID** is required for voting, unless an exception applies. College student ID's and out-of-state photo ID's will not be accepted. Forms of acceptable identification, even if expired, include a Tennessee driver license with your photo, United States passport, Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security photo ID, Photo ID issued by the federal government, United States military ID including a Veteran Identification Card, and a Tennessee handgun carry permit with your photo. ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL (TCA 2-6-201)

A person who wishes to vote absentee by mail and meets the qualifications may obtain an application in person at the Loudon County Election Commission Office, by e-mail or U.S. Mail. - The absentee application must be completed in full and returned no later than **July 27, 2026**, to the Loudon County Election Commission Office to be properly processed.
 - The voter's absentee ballot must be received by mail or courier service no later than 8 P.M. or the close of the polls **August 6, 2026**, at the Loudon County Election Commission Office to be eligible to be counted.
- Ballots cannot be hand delivered by the voter.**
