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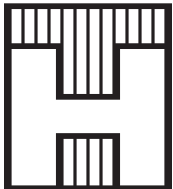

Public or private? It's a question countless Bay Area families ask every year. Education is one of the most important decisions – and investments – you'll make in your children's lives, starting with preschool and continuing through college and beyond. For some parents, private schools represent the best option. If you're reading this guide, chances are you've already made that decision or are close to reaching it.

With a proven track record, private schools maintain high standards not only for academics, but for fostering communication among parents, faculty and administrators that creates a community beneficial to students' growth and success.

In addition to focusing on academics (including science, technology, engineering and math curriculum) and preparation for college, private schools emphasize the arts, languages, athletics and community engagement.

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Parents Should Look for Community and Culture to Find Best Fit

What is the responsibility of a private school? The Bay Area is blessed with many of them, so in this robust market, a strong academic program should be a given. When looking for the right-fit school for their child, families should focus on two key elements—community and culture.

As private school educators, we know we must prepare our students for college. We know we must provide a rich, multicultural and multidimensional experience in the classroom. And we know we must be ready to adapt at a moment's notice to the changing needs of education. Now more than ever, our most vital responsibility is to create a culture that develops confident, capable, and kind students.

The fast-moving changes and interruptions caused by the pandemic have highlighted the importance of restoring and maintaining a joyful school culture. The values and beliefs that a school puts into practice every day define its culture and creating that unique culture is a community undertaking that involves every teacher, parent, student, and administrator.

A strong school community means students are not the only ones learning and growing; they are inspiring faculty to raise the bar and learn alongside them. This relational learning model—one that relies on the authentic connection between teachers and students — means high academic and personal expectations are met in an environment that fuels a lifetime love of learning and discovery.

When students are happy and flourishing, they are more motivated and effective learners.

Challenges feel less insurmountable, change is less scary, and taking (age-appropriate) risks becomes exciting. Intentional programs and experiences like advisory, student trips, buddy programs, and DEIB workshops are essential to making sure every person in



a school community is seen, known, and cherished.

How strongly students feel like they “belong” at school can shape their entire life. And when students have a strong community and sense of belonging at school, a whole host of benefits follow, including greater academic motivation, and better mental health outcomes. In addition, teachers in K-12 private schools have the distinct benefit of seeing a wide-angle view of each child's growth and development over the years. Which in turn means they are well positioned

to provide a classroom environment that is rooted in respect, inclusion, and acceptance.

It is paramount to build a school environment that is flexible, provides autonomy, and allows students to ask hard questions and make reasoned choices. Questions like What matters to me? What do I focus on? How do I spend my time? How do I take advantage of support systems and advocate for myself? What are the trade-offs that come with difficult decisions? The students who will succeed in this rapidly-changing, global

world are the ones who can define—and redefine—their personal values. Therefore, educational institutions must be a space where children feel free to express and live out those values every day.

The pandemic has impacted family decision-making, and right now people are making decisions that align with their values. They're looking for similar values in their jobs, where they live, their relationships, and especially in where they choose to send their child to school. Parents are no longer looking for just the picture-perfect college preparatory school – they want more. They are looking for schools to intentionally create meaningful school/parent partnerships, openly acknowledge mistakes when necessary, and clearly articulate and live out their distinct purpose, all while ensuring every student is both empowered and supported to succeed. How well students are prepared to accomplish their current and future academic, professional, and personal goals is one way to define success. Non-academic factors such as being a good coworker and team player, having perseverance and a good work ethic, and the ability to think critically and problem solve matters more than any



grade ever could.

So the responsibility of educators is more nuanced than ever. Schools must not only be versed in up-to-date pedagogical approaches, but they must also be well versed in the social-emotional needs of every member of their community. At the end of the day, strong school culture is forged in

partnership between teachers, students, and families—all working together to transcend traditional markers of success and empower students to enter the world as compassionate, capable, and kind citizens.

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Nurturing Student Well-Being in a Faith-Based Environment

Private education attracted an unprecedented interest during the disorienting disruption of schooling from the global pandemic. Last year, an increasing number of parents pursued private education, with over 40% of polled parents preferring private education (EdChoice), viewing it as a pathway that offered stability and strategic adaptiveness to meet the needs of students and their families during a most challenging time.

Private education has earned a reputation of academic excellence with outstanding educators, smaller classes, and better campus facilities. Much has been written about the value proposition

of private education for these reasons. Private schools are well known for high quality academics, competitive athletics and an array of arts programs. Yet, what is often overlooked and as critical as academic outcomes is another kind of quality education that deserves more consideration, that is; student well-being.

Student well-being has emerged as the centermost educational issue in 2022 and private schools are at the forefront in their responsiveness, especially those schools founded in a mission of holistic education — intellectual, spiritual, psychological, emotional, and physical care for the whole person — devoting curricular emphasis and allocating the resources to support students. In particular, faith-based education, clearly an option for many families, focuses on grounding students in a sacred life of purpose.

Parents need to find the best fit for every child. Being thoughtful about asking more questions like, “How many counselors are there? What substantive investments has the school made in emotional and social well-being? Are there mindfulness initiatives that help deal with stress? Retreat programs?” “In what ways are parents also engaged to

strengthen the fabric of the community?” These questions not only demonstrate the importance of student well-being but also an awareness of the power of a holistic approach to education and a commitment to being engaged as a supportive member of the school community.

Outcomes may be clear on paper, but a visit to the school campus during a school day will give you the feel of the school. The climate, the mix of students, laughter and actual joy are important indicators. When surveyed last year a prospective parent reflected, “Sacred Heart Cathedral has so much heart. It was always visible when we visited.”

These intangibles form us in ways that can be transformative, as each of us experiences in situ socialization through immersive learning experiences which shape our worldview and the ways the world views us. Students and their families may choose private education for the strength of the academics and programs but it is imperative that they feel that sense of belonging in a welcoming and nurturing community.

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Diversity Fosters Respect for Self, Others

Good private high schools are known for the close working relationship of faculty, staff, administration and parents. Compared to most public schools, private schools have smaller class sizes and more opportunities to participate in co-curricular activities. Parents should also expect aligned personal values and an opportunity to work together with private high school educators to prepare the student not just academically, but to be a responsible citizen of the world.

In most private high schools, parents should find academic rigor. Parents can choose among the private high



schools based on the type of academic experience available. Some high schools may strongly feature the arts, others excel at science, and so on. Most have professional development programs for their faculty to remain innovative.

Beyond the academic offerings, parents can choose what type of experience and atmosphere is best for

their child's development. Some schools cater to those families in a certain area. Some are faith-based. Some may feature a student body composed of students from a diversity of backgrounds and cultures providing countless opportunities for personal development enriching the academic experience.

Exposure to diversity in all forms, increases personal growth, respect for others, empathy and self-control. At Salesian College Preparatory in Richmond, we are proud of our richly diverse mosaic of students who excel academically in a safe, welcoming environment designed to allow each student to achieve their own maximum potential. 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Glossary of Terms

Charter School

A state-funded, tuition-free public school typically authorized by the state board of education, a local public school board or county board of education. Each charter school establishes its own educational focus and philosophy. In exchange for agreeing to be held accountable for providing a distinctive educational program and achieving specific goals, charter schools are granted greater flexibility than traditional public schools. For example, startup charter schools, unlike traditional public schools, don't have to become subject to collective bargaining agreements with school staff.

For-Profit School

An organization in which a private school operates as a business with a purpose to generate profit. Most for-profit schools are owned by individuals or corporations. While nearly a third of all California private schools are organized on a for-profit basis, such schools account for slightly over 10% of the state's total private school K-12 enrollment.

Independent School

Incorporated on a nonprofit basis and governed by a board of directors, this type of school is independent of any other organizational entity. Independent schools can be religiously oriented or affiliated, but must be autonomously governed. Most schools of this type are affiliated with and accredited by the California Association of Independent Schools; a number also belong to the National Association of Independent Schools.

Montessori School

A school whose view of child development, educational philosophy and instructional methods is grounded in the work of Italian physician and educator Maria Montessori (1870-1952). While Montessori schools offer instruction for infants through adolescents, most focus on early childhood education. Montessori education emphasizes fostering a child's natural inclination to learn, and teachers guide rather than instruct, linking each student with activities that meet the child's interests, needs and developmental

level.

Nonprofit School

A form of incorporation that bars distribution of corporate assets to shareholders or members. In California, just over two-thirds of private schools operate on the nonprofit basis, though such schools account for nearly 90% of the state's total private school enrollment. Most California nonprofit private schools are incorporated as either public benefit corporations or religious nonprofit corporations. Nonprofit private schools

typically engage in fundraising to balance their operating budget. Should revenue exceed expense, the excess must be reinvested to achieve the school's goals rather than distributed as profit. Most nonprofit private schools have been granted 501(c)(3) status by the Internal Revenue Service, exempting them from taxes and permitting them to accept tax-deductible contributions.

Nonpublic School

A private school in which students may be placed and funded by an agency



of the state. Some nonpublic schools also enroll students on a private-pay tuition basis. While in many states, the term nonpublic school is used interchangeably with private school, California Education Code Section 56034 defines a nonpublic, nonsectarian school as “a private, nonsectarian school that enrolls individuals with exceptional needs pursuant to an individualized educational program.” California’s nonpublic schools are subject to annual certification and thrice yearly onsite reviews by the California Department of Education.

Nonsectarian School

In broad usage, a private school with a secular orientation. Some use the term nonsectarian in conjunction with religious schools to denote Christian schools that are not affiliated with a particular denomination. Some Christian schools, for example, identify as Evangelical or simply Christian.

Parochial School

A school operated or supported by a particular church or religious denomination. In broad usage, such schools embrace a religious affiliation



and offer both secular and religious instruction in a learning and living environment guided by religious traditions and values. The term parochial school can also denote a Catholic school generally subject to the authority of its parish and diocese. Nearly three-quarters of all students enrolled in California private

schools attend a school with a religious orientation.

Private School

A school that is neither operated nor funded by an agency of government. A private school may be organized on a nonprofit basis, operate as a business or take the form of a home school. All offer full-time instruction with a full complement of subjects at the elementary, middle or high school level and provide direct accountability to students, parents or guardians.

Waldorf School

A school whose view of human development, curriculum and learning derives from the work of Austrian philosopher and teacher Rudolf Steiner (1861-1925). Waldorf educators regard education as an art that addresses students’ intellectual, emotional, physical and spiritual capacities. Strongly humanistic, the Waldorf approach emphasizes creativity, developmental appropriateness and the joyful aspects of learning.

Redefining The Classroom Environment

Terra Marin rewrites the story, bringing education through a neuroscience lens with its student-centered educational philosophy. Terra Marin is a PK-8th grade independent, nonprofit school with a coeducational curriculum that is stimulating, contemporary, and innovative, integrating Language Arts, STEAM, Earth Education, World languages (Mandarin and Spanish) and Specialist classes (Drama, Art, and Music) through a blend of guided discovery and project-based learning. This curriculum is based on four elements:

FAQs About Private Schools

To choose the right private school, rely on your knowledge of your child and family, taking into account your values, education philosophy and youngster's particular needs. Parents should visit schools, review school literature and talk to principals and admissions directors to make informed decisions. Here are some important questions to ask:

How do I apply? The best time to apply is in the fall of the year preceding enrollment, but many schools accept and consider applications throughout the year. To begin the process, call or write the admissions office to request a brochure and other pertinent materials. Consulting a school's website also may provide valuable information. Most

schools require an interview, admissions testing and records from the student's previous school. Also, many admissions officers and principals recommend visiting and attending events such as games and performances at schools your child would like to attend.

How can I identify high-quality and committed teachers?
