Ordinance No. 006a-26

An Ordinance creating the Non-bargaining position of Electric Line Foreman for the City of Napoleon, Ohio; and Declaring an Emergency

In this legislation, the City of Napoleon created the non-bargaining position of Line Foreman for the City.

Ordinance No. 009-26

An Ordinance Supplementing the Annual Appropriation Measure (Supplement No. 1) for the Year 2026; and Declaring an Emergency

In this legislation, the City of Napoleon authorized the City Finance Director to supplement the annual appropriation measure for the year 2026.

Ordinance No. 010-26

An Ordinance Authorizing the Finance Director to make Appropriation Transfer (Transfers of Appropriation 1) from one Appropriation line item to another Appropriation Line Item Pursuant to ORC. Section 5705.40 for the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2026 as listed in Exhibit A; and Declaring an Emergency

In this legislation, the City of Napoleon authorized the City Finance Director to make appropriation transfers pursuant to ORC 5705.40 for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026.

Resolution No. 008-26

A Resolution authorizing the City of Napoleon to remain in the Maumee Valley East CHIP Consortium in order to submit an application for the fiscal year 2026 Community Housing Improvement Program (CHIP) funds to the Ohio Development Services Agency; and declaring an Emergency

In this legislation, the City of Napoleon authorized remaining in the Maumee Valley Chip Consortium and submit an application for CHIP funds in fiscal year 2026.

Resolution No. 011-26

A Resolution authorizing the Finance Director to transfer certain fund balances (Transfer No. 1) from respective funds to other funds pursuant to ORC. Section 5705.14 on an as needed basis in Fiscal Year 2026, as listed in Exhibit A; and Declaring an Emergency
