In this legislation, the City of Napoleon authorized appointing David Busick as the City Law Director.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A FISCAL YEAR 2026 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

In this legislation, the City of Napoleon authorized the City Manager to apply for and accept the AFG grant from the Department of Homeland Security and FEMA.
