DIRECTOR/DEPUTY DIRECTOR (DEMOCRAT)

The Henry County Board of Elections is seeking applicants for a Deputy Director (Democrat). The Director and Deputy Director are responsible for overseeing, directing, and managing staff and operations within the Board of Elections; conducting fair and impartial elections; and following all rules and regulations established by the Ohio Revised Code, relevant federal legislation, the Ohio Secretary of State, and the Henry County Board of Elections.

Applicants must have a high school diploma or the equivalency of a high school diploma (GED). College level education is desired, but it is not required. Applicants must be a registered Democrat and a resident of Henry County or willing to move within 30 days of their hire date.

Applicants must possess a baseline understanding of the rules, processes, procedures, and equipment used in local election administration. In addition, applicants must demonstrate the requisite experience and capability necessary to manage the day-to-day operations of the Henry County Board of Elections.

All applicants are subject to a criminal background check.
