Future ‘budget season’ steps to come:

- Sept. 16:** Lincoln County Agricultural Society sets budget.
- Sept. 17:** Educational Service Unit 16 sets budget.
- Sept. 23:** Lincoln County, North Platte Airport Authority set budgets.
- Sept. 25:** Mid-Plains Community College Area sets budget.
- Sept. 30:** Deadline to file completed budgets with Nebraska State Auditor’s Office.
- Oct. 20:** Deadline for county boards to ratify property tax rates.
- Fall, TBA:** State sets percentages for Property Tax Relief Fund and education tax credits.
