



Taylor Loyd Miss North Carolina 2023

Guest of Honor Taylor Loyd coming to Strawberry Festival

Carolina 2023 is a graduating senior at UNC-Chapel Hill studying psychology and music (classical vocal performance). Originally from Mooresville, she is a 14th generation North Carolinian and will represent the Tar Heel State at the Miss America 2024 Competition.

At the Miss North Carolina 2023 Competition she was awarded \$27,000 in scholarship assistance to pursue her educational and professional goals, but has earned over \$32,000 in scholarships since beginning her involvement as a teen in 2017. She plans to pursue a graduate degree and career in opera performance, and hopes to eventually teach students in a collegiate setting.

When Taylor was 7 years old, her vounger brother was injured in a traumatic accident that changed her family's lives forever. Inspired by the healing power of music and art resources made available to herself, her brother and her family, Taylor founded Healing Hearts Through the Arts, 501(c) (3), a nonprofit aimed to provide music and art resources, education and advocacy as a tool for

Taylor Loyd, Miss North mental health and wellbeing. Through her organization, she has presented to thousands of schoolchildren, veterans, policymakers and peers about the intersection of mental health and the arts, collected over 7,000 music and art supplies, and worked with policymakers from local N.C. communities all the way to Capitol Hill in promotion of her initiative.

Taylor has served as the Vice President of Recruitment for UNC Panhellenic Council. Co-Director of UNC Music Department Ambassadors, a UNC-CH Gillings School of Global Public Health Undergraduate Research Assistant, Support Professional for special-needs adults, Leadership Fellow at Addiction Professionals of N.C., winner of 2022 UNC Symphony Orchestra Concerto Competition, and recent opera credits include Mabel in The Pirates of Penzance (2022) and Phoebe in The Yeomen of the Guard (2023.)

In her free time, Taylor enjoys hiking new destinations, cooking creative recipes, singing all genres of music and spending quality time with family, friends, and her rescue cat, Lottie.







Entries will be accepted at the church from 8:30-10 a.m. on Saturday and must be ready to display before they are registered. Participants will not be allowed at the display tables.

Recipes are to be written or typed on 5x8 index cards and left with the strawberry dish. Judging will occur from 10–11 a.m. The food exhibits will be reopened for public viewing at 11 a.m. and will remain on

display until participants pick up their entries by 2 p.m.

The contest is designed to promote the use of the strawberry as a nutritious and palatable product and the contest is designed so that a person of any age or sex may enter. Novice and experienced cooks have enjoyed presenting both traditional and innovative recipes, and over the years the cooks have enjoyed receiving acclaim for the

Three cash prizes, \$15 blue ribbon, \$10 red ribbon and \$5 white ribbon, will be offered in both the adult and youth (kindergarten through high school senior) divisions.

Qualified judges from a wide geographical area will judge the entries. They include retired extension home agents and school cafeteria personnel.

The N.C. Strawberry Foods Contest has been one of the highlights of the festival for many years, and members of the Chadbourn Extension and Community Association pride themselves in sponsoring the event.


Following are the contest rules:

1. The contest will be divided into two divisions:

A. Adult B. Youth (kindergarten through high school senior).

2. Dishes will be judged in five categories in each division. Only one entry from an indi-

vidual in each category.



- B. Cakes. (One-fourth of a cake is acceptable or a whole cake may be entered.) No slices or squares accepted.
- C. Pastries. Pies and Tarts. (Pastries: two individual servings of each recipe are acceptable. Pies: an eight-inch pie is acceptable.)

D. Salads and Other Desserts. (Includes all types of gelatin dishes, ice cream, etc. Two individual servings are acceptable.)

E. Low Calorie or Sugar Free.

The food exhibit will be closed to the public during judging and will reopen at 11 a.m., remaining open until 2 p.m.

Prizes will consist of cash awards (\$15 and blue ribbon for first place); (\$10 and red ribbon for second place); (\$5 and white ribbon for third place in each of the categories).

Participants will be responsible for collecting their dishes and prizes at 2 p.m. on contest

No entries will be sold or sampled by the public.

Recipes are to be written on 5x8 inch index cards and left with the strawberry dish. The correct ingredients and method for preparing should be listed. The recipes become the property of the Chadbourn Extension and Community Association.

Strawberry culture and the Strawberry Festival

Strawberry culture began in Chadbourn in 1895 when Joseph Addison Brown, merchant farmer and North Carolina state senator, bought and/or developed thousands of acres of timber lands of the Chadbourn area for productive farm lands. With the Wilson Publishing Company of Chicago, Illinois, a colony was formed named the Sunny South Colony.

Thus the advertisement for this desirable climate and fertile soil brought an estimated 160 families to the Sunny South Colony after 1895. Some of the colonists were successful, and many of the local farmers began the cultivation of strawberries.

The first planting

The first planting of strawberries failed in 1895, but the next year, six and three-quarter acres of berries were planted and J.A. Brown sold berries for a value of \$5,562. The growth of the industry continued and in 1907, 347,000 thirty-two quart crates were shipped and Chadbourn became the Klondyke Strawberry Capital of the World. In 1907, the largest one-day shipment of strawberries was made. One hundred eighty railroad box carloads of strawberries, all of which had been harvested between sunrise and sunset, requiring 15,000 workers, were moved by rail from Chadbourn to points all over the country.

The continued success of the industry eventually became a reason for entertainment. In order to commemorate the 30th anniversary of the strawberry industry, the first Strawberry Festival was inaugurated on May 26, 1926.

Chadbourn is located at the intersection of Hwy. 74/76 and Hwy. 410. It is approximately an one-hour drive from Wilmington and Myrtle Beach. The festival is held at Strawberry Blvd. and Brown Street.


