Hearing the song “Away in a Manger” still brings me a happy memory of that day.

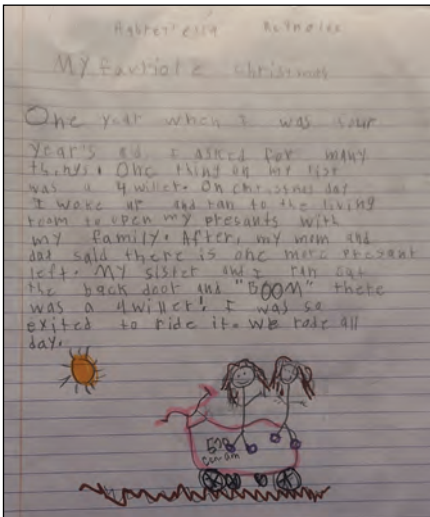
