Things to fee &







North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences at Whiteville

A branch of the N.C. Museum of Natural Sciences, the museum features an Investigation Lab, Naturalist Center, Outdoor Nature Play Space, and Discovery Forest. It offers education and inspiration to visitors free of charge.

Lake Waccamaw State Park

The state park offers public access to Lake Waccamaw, a shallow Carolina bay lake that's one of the largest natural bodies of water between New York and Florida. The park includes more than 2,000 acres of forest and shoreline. Amenities include a boat ramp, primitive campsites, hiking trails, a long boardwalk that extends into the 3x5-mile lake, and a visitors' center with regular programs.

The Lumber River Riverwalk

The riverwalk offers beautiful lowland scenery, with access located in downtown Fair Bluff. Enjoy a casual stroll by the river, or, if you are seeking adventure, use the boat ramp for kayaking or canoeing.

Reuben Brown House

This farmhouse from the early 1800s houses the Reuben Brown House Preservation Society, an organization of concerned citizens dedicated to preserving local history with period music and literature events.

Veterans Memorial Park of America

Just south of Whiteville, this memorial park honors past, present and future veterans for their service to our country.

Columbus County Community Farmers Market

Every Saturday from May to December, the market brings farmers and artisans together with loyal patrons for some of the finest and freshest locally grown produce, handmade crafts, sweet and savory treats, local honey, eggs, herbs, plants and much more.

Historic Railroad Depots

Columbus County has six historic railroad depots, with the depots in Lake Waccamaw, Chadbourn, Fair Bluff and Tabor City also serving as museums. The Riegelwood depot is that community's library, and the Whiteville depot, known as Vineland Station, is the town's civic center and hosts a large number of events.

Columbus County Parks and Community Centers

Columbus County Parks and Recreation maintains over twenty parks and community centers across the county, each with unique amenities. Residents and visitors of all ages can use walking trails, softball and baseball fields, tennis courts, basketball courts, playgrounds and many other features. The Julie M. Strickland Fitness Park in Whiteville is one of the newest additions and includes a walking track, a Fitness Court outdoor gym facility and an inclusive playground for children and adults of all abilities.

Whiteville Butterfly Trail and Murals

Stroll or drive around Whiteville and you'll see beautiful butterfly murals all around town. Civic organizations and clubs sponsored these public art projects created by local artist Bess Taylor. Take a selfie or just enjoy the butterflies at the N.C. Museum of Natural Sciences at Whiteville, Columbus County Arts Council, Columbus Regional Healthcare System, Vineland Storage, Columbus County Community Farmers Market, Julie M. Strickland Fitness Park and various downtown locations.





Healthcare, Business & Industry

Healthcare

Columbus County residents have access to dynamic and progressive healthcare through the services of superb healthcare practitioners; Columbus Regional Healthcare System, the county's full-service hospital; and emergency outpatient facilities.



Providers serve the county with a range of medical services including outpatient labs, diagnostic testing, physical therapy, cardiac rehabilitation, diabetes education, cancer care, hospice, pediatrics, imaging services, gynecology, urology, dental care, and orthodontics. Additionally, residents are eligible for a variety of services through the Columbus County Health Department.

Business and Industry

Columbus County offers strategic access to Interstates 95 and 40 via U.S. 74, which runs east to west through the county. The Port of Wilmington is less than one hour east, and a web of federal and state highways allows employees to reach their employers with ease. A rail line through the county links the Port of Wilmington to Charlotte.



Commercial airline service is available at nearby Wilmington (ILM), Fayetteville (FAY), and Myrtle Beach (MYR) airports, each approximately an hour away, with Raleigh-Durham International Airport (RDU) just two and a half hours away. Private and corporate aircraft are facilitated by Columbus County Airport's (CPC) 5,500-foot runway just south of Whiteville.

Four prime county industrial sites are: the Southeast Regional Park next to Southeastern Community College in Whiteville, the Tabor Industrial Park in Tabor City, the Columbus County Cape Fear River Site in Riegelwood, and the International Logistics Park of North Carolina in Delco. Southeast, Tabor, and the International Logistics Park have each met the comprehensive standards of North Carolina's Certified Sites program and are fully served with electricity, water, natural gas, sewer, high-speed internet, and rail.

Skills development training is also available for the specific purposes of training an individual for employment, upgrading skills of the presently employed, and retraining others for new employment in occupational fields.

Whiteville

With a population of more than 5,000 residents, the City of Whiteville serves as the county seat for Columbus County. Named for the original owner of the town site, James B. White, in 1810, the city lies along major thoroughfares U.S. 74, U.S. 76 and U.S. 701.

The city is home to the North Carolina Museum of Natural Sciences at Whiteville and has a vibrant downtown with unique restaurants and shops. Vineland Station, built in 1903, is one of North Carolina's original brick depots and serves as the town's civic center. The Columbus County Courthouse in Whiteville is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The N.C. Pecan Music Festival takes place in the city each November.

Tabor City

Founded as a rural market town on the Atlantic Coast Railroad in 1905, Tabor City borders the state of South Carolina. Within 30 minutes of the beaches of the Grand Strand in Horry County, S.C., the town is home to award-winning campgrounds, muscadine wines, and family values. Visitors can tour a historic one-room schoolhouse from 1870, see the historic Tabor City Railroad Depot that maintains artifacts of the town's rich tobacco and lumber industries, or spend time at Lake Tabor, a 100+ acre recreational lake that's home to fishing, boating, picnics, and ball fields.

In the mid-1930s, Tabor City became known as the "Yam Capital of the World." The North Carolina Yam Festival takes place in the town annually in October to pay tribute to the sweet potato.

















Lake Waccamaw

Established in 1911, the town of Lake Waccamaw is a small community on the shores of the largest natural freshwater lake in North Carolina. In less than 4 square miles, the town offers friendly neighbors, access to a prehistoric lake, rich Native American history, and an abundance of fish, reptiles, birds and endangered plant species.

A historic train station built in 1904 by the Atlantic Coast Line Railroad serves as the town's museum. Residents and visitors alike take advantage of Lake Waccamaw for swimming, paddling, running and biking in organized fitness events throughout the year and for daily exercise.

Chadbourn

Incorporated in 1883, Chadbourn began as a railroad town centered around a station formerly known as Timberville. Nicknamed 'The Sunny South Colony,' the town was named after the Chadbourn family of Wilmington and was an important railway center. Strawberries were the crop that brought the town into prominence, and in the first three decades of the 20th century, long lines of farmers awaited turns at the town's auction shed. Chadbourn is host to the N.C. Strawberry Festival, the longest-running agricultural festival in the state.



Fair Bluff

Nestled against the banks of the nationally recognized Wild and Scenic Lumber River, the community of Fair Bluff was incorporated in 1873. The town's earliest inhabitants were turpentiners, lumbermen, and merchants. The Fair Bluff Depot, built in 1887, is now a museum filled with treasures and relics of the town's history.

The town boasts a beautiful elevated river walk that follows the course of the Lumber River and offers a stroll with nature. Each April, the town hosts BBQ on the Bluff, a barbeque cooking competition featuring some of the finest cooks in North and South Carolina.

From the small towns of Bolton, Sandyfield, Cerro Gordo, Boardman, and Brunswick to the communities of Mount Olive, Buckhead, Hallsboro, Riegelwood, Evergreen, Nakina, St. James, Old Dock, and Williams Township, Columbus County offers locations that fit the lifestyle of any family.

Bolton, on the eastern end of the county, is home to the annual Pine Tree Festival. Buckhead, near Bolton, is home to the Waccamaw Siouan Tribe, one of eight state-recognized Native American tribal nations in North Carolina. Williams Township, south of Whiteville, is a farming community anchored by Williams Township School, serving kindergarten through eighth grade.

Mount Olive, north of Whiteville, is a community organized around the historic Mount Olive Missionary Baptist Church, founded in 1872 by African-American pastor Rev. John Washington Worley. Cerro Gordo, on the western end of the county along U.S. 76, has the highest elevation in the county and according to legend was named after the "Battle of Cerro Gordo" in the Mexican-American War.










