Downtown Historic Fair Bluff welcomes everyone to come, bring the family, and have fun during this year's Watermelon Festival.





This year, the 15th Annual Fair Bluff Rotary Duck Race will be held on Saturday, Aug. 14, at 2 p.m. The race is the signature fundraiser for The Rotary Club of Fair Bluff. The race will be held as part of the annual Fair Bluff Watermelon Festival.

The race can be viewed from the riverwalk of the Lumber River, adjacent to Riverside Drive in the Town of Fair Bluff. For those unable to attend the race in person, the race will be broadcast live online, and can be viewed at facebook. com/fairbluffwatermelonfestival.



Fair Bluff Watermelon Festival 2021 Rules and Guidelines for the Quality/ Sweetness Contest

- 1. Watermelons will be accepted from the counties of Columbus, Bladen, Brunswick, and Robeson in North Carolina. Entries may also be from Horry, Marion or Dillon counties in South Carolina.
- 2. Growers must bring two watermelons of the same variety to enter in the contest. The judges will have the ultimate choice as to which watermelon they will cut to be judged.
- 3. Only one entry per person is allowed in the quality/sweetness contest. There will be no more than two entries (four melons total) per family/farm. (The entry may be in more than one person's name. For example if you have four children, one entry may be in two of their names and the other entry in the other two names.)
- 4. Each grower must bring two (2) watermelons to Riverside Drive behind Main Street on Aug. 14, between 7–9 a.m. When watermelons are checked in, each grower will be assigned a number which will be placed on the grower's watermelons prior to the beginning of judging.
- 5. The overall winner, with the highest score, of the quality

- contest will claim the title of the "Best Tasting Watermelon of the Fair Bluff Watermelon Contest."
- 6. The first place Quality Winner will be asked to ride in the Fair Bluff Watermelon Parade. The parade will begin at 12:30 p.m. and the first place winner must report to parade line-up by noon. (Vehicle and signs will be provided for the winner to ride in the parade.)

If additional information is needed for the quality contest, please contact either co-chairman of the Fair Bluff Water-melon contests, Sawyer Enzor Strickland at 919-576-4159 or Adam Worley at 910-207-8538.

There will be no auction this year and only one quality contest. Thanks to our generous sponsors we will be awarding monetary prizes to the first through 10th place growers on the day of the contest. The first place quality melon grower will be awarded \$300.

- 2. Only one entry per person is allowed in the largest/size contest.
- 3. Each grower must bring their entry to Riverside Drive behind Main Street on Aug. 14, 2021, between 7 9 a.m. When watermelons are checked in, each grower will be assigned a number which will be placed on the grower's watermelon prior to the official weighing.
- 4. The first place winner will be asked to ride in the Fair Bluff Watermelon Parade. The parade will begin at 12:30 p.m. and the first place winner with their melon must report to parade line-up by noon. (Vehicle and signs will be provided for the winner to ride in the parade.)
