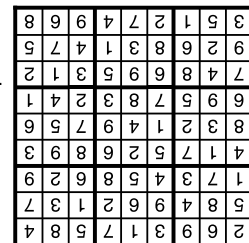
# SUDOKU

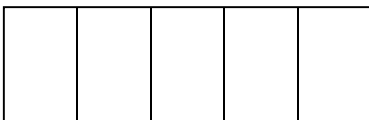
