Meals on Wheels of Northwest Indiana (MOWNWI) prepares and delivers essential nutritious meals, promoting the health, wellness, and independence of members of our community, with the support of a diverse and engaged community network.

MOWNWI was established in July of 1977 by Margot Clark, a social worker with the Visiting Nurses Association (VNA). Clark started Meals on Wheels of Northwest Indiana as a service of the Visiting Nurse Association.


Today, the organization is led by CEO, Ryan Elinkowski. Ryan has spent the last 15 years serving adults, children, and families through his work at St. Jude House Domestic Violence Shelter and Prevention Center, and the Boys and Girls Clubs of Northwest Indiana.

MOWNWI has been delivering hot nutritious meals to the doorsteps of clients nearly 50 years. The organization has grown from serving just three meals in 1977 to now delivering 10,000 meals each week. MOWNWI also delivers supper meals, frozen meals, and meals to children at daycare centers and adults at numerous congregate sites throughout seven NWI counties including: Lake, Porter, Jasper, Newton, Starke, Pulaski and prepares the meals for the LaPorte County program. In 2025, MOWNWI produced and delivered a record number of 519,020 meals!
