The Lottery / IGT Indiana relationship is grounded in a spirit of cooperation that is integral to the successful operation of the Integrated Services Agreement.

Matters Subject to Dispute

Provider's Unrecovered Shortfall -- \$18.25M

Passage of HEA 1260 – at least \$2.056M/year

Fast Play Golden Jackpot -- \$3.17M

The settlement ensures that:

- IGT Indiana can no longer pursue a claim for extra incentive payments associated with the Lottery's record net income performance in FY21, or any other year prior to the settlement.
- As of the settlement effective date, IGT Indiana will not be eligible to pursue any incentive payments beyond a 5% annual cap.
- IGT Indiana can no longer pursue a reduction in annual Provider Net Income thresholds based on the passage of HEA 1260.
- The Lottery retains all existing contractual remedies necessary to continue holding IGT Indiana accountable for performing all services at the highest standards.

The parties believe that their interests are adequately addressed by the settlement and have pledged to continue working in good faith to fulfill the Lottery's statutory purposes with a renewed commitment to the Integrated Service Agreement's spirit of cooperation.

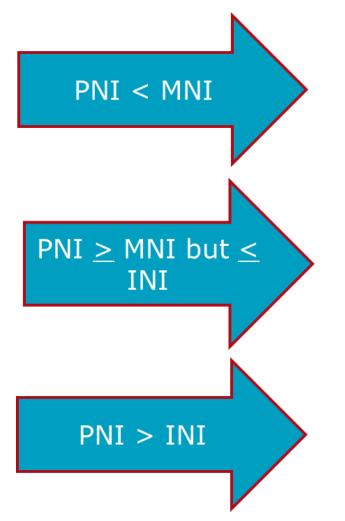




