On behalf of the Tom McDermott Campaign, Change Research polled 2111 likely voters in Indiana. The margin of error as traditionally calculated is 2.6%. Change Research reaches voters via targeted online ads & text messages that point people to an online survey instrument. Post stratification was done on region, gender, age, education, ethnicity, and 2020 presidential vote.
