United States Service Academy Information Form

The United States Service Academies prepare men and women to be professional officers in the armed services and in the Merchant Marine. The academies are:

The United States Air Force Academy
Colorado Springs, Colorado

The United States Military Academy
West Point, New York

The United States Naval Academy
Annapolis, Maryland

The Merchant Marine Academy
Kings Point, New York

United States Service Academy Admissions Process

Each academy has its own admissions program. To be considered for admissions to one of the service academies listed above, an applicant must attain a nomination. A nominating letter from a U.S. Representative or Senator is one type of nomination. Individuals seeking a nomination from Congressman Mrvan for the July 2022 session must submit a completed application form, in addition to the required supplemental materials, by **October 29, 2021**. An official application for a Congressional nomination is attached.

Applicants are also required to **apply directly to the academies they wish to attend before applying to my office**. The academy admissions process is initiated by filling out an application on their website. Applicants are urged to contact the academies of their choice and submit the online application as soon as possible.

Qualified individuals may also apply for other types of nominations. Please consult the academy catalogs for information on these nomination procedures.

Academy Eligibility Requirements

Candidates for admissions to a United States Service Academy must meet the following minimum requirements as of July 1, 2022:

1. The applicant must be a United States citizen.
2. The applicant must be at least 17 but not yet 23 years of age (applicants to the Merchant Marine Academy must be at least 17 but not yet 25 years of age).
3. The applicant must not be married, pregnant, or have legal obligation for child support of a child or other dependents.
4. The applicant must meet all other specific requirements as indicated in the academy information catalogs.

United States Coast Guard Academy

The United States Coast Guard Academy does not require a Congressional nomination.

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Congressional Nomination Requirements

Candidates wishing to receive an academy nomination from Congressman Mrvan must meet the following requirements:

1. The applicant must be a legal resident of Indiana's First Congressional District.
2. The Applicant must submit a completed application with the following materials to Congressman Mrvan by **October 29, 2021**:
 - A) Official high school and/or college transcripts.
 - B) Three letters of recommendation (at least one must be from a Math, Science, or English teacher).
 - C) SAT or ACT scores. If so indicated, the Educational Testing Service will forward SAT and/or ACT scores directly to Congressman Mrvan. To forward SAT scores, students should use code **1888** on the SAT application form. To forward ACT scores, students should use code **7397** on the application form.
 - D) A typed essay of no more than 250 words detailing why the applicant would like to attend a service academy and become a professional officer in one of the services.

Qualified applicants will be interviewed in November by Congressman Mrvan's Academy Selection Committee. The committee will screen applicants for scholastic ability, leadership potential, adequacy of preparation, and sincerity to attend a service academy.
