ORDER CERTIFYING INTERLOCUTORY APPEAL

The Court, having read and reviewed the Joint Motion to Certify Order for Interlocutory Appeal filed by the defendants Smith & Wesson Corp., Sturm, Ruger & Company, Inc., Colt's Manufacturing Company LLC, Beretta U.S.A. 
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Court as follows:
