Joseph R. Heerens (Chairman)



Joseph R. Heerens (Chairman) of Carmel, Indiana, previously served as General Counsel & Ethics Officer for the Office of Governor Holcomb. Prior to that, he served as General Counsel, Government Affairs Director & Ethics Officer for the Indianapolis Airport Authority, where he was active in other organizations including a committee at the National Academy of Sciences (Transportation Research Board, ACRP), serving as chair of the State Employees' Appeals Commission, and participating in the FBI Citizens Academy. Before his Airport service, Mr. Heerens was Chief Legislative Counsel, Policy Director & Deputy General Counsel for Governor Mitch Daniels. He has also served as Senior Vice President & Assistant Corporate Secretary of a public corporation, and chaired the Government Affairs Committee for the national association where he had the privilege of testifying before several U.S. Congressional committees as well as representing the association in meetings with White House staff. Other civic and community involvement included service on boards such as the Indiana Legal Foundation, Indiana Chamber of Commerce, and the American Heart Association (AHA) where he chaired two national committees at the AHA's headquarters in Dallas, Texas

Statewide casino revenues rose by 2.29%, from \$2.28 billion to \$2.33 billion in FY 25. Casino wagering taxes for FY 25 were \$574.8 million, which was a 1.98% increase over FY 24. Supplemental taxes for FY 25 totaled \$49.9 million, up 2.80% from FY 24. Year over year, wagering and supplemental taxes were up \$11.1 million and \$1.4 million, respectively.

The total state-wide casino win was \$2.46 billion, up 2.17% from \$2.40 billion the fiscal year prior. The Northern Indiana market saw a 3.44% decrease to \$983.5 million. The racinos also experienced a 2.88% increase to \$579.9 million. While the southern Indiana market realized a 8.78% increase to \$894.0 million.

Sports wagering taxes were up 14.3%, from \$43.0 million in FY 24 to \$49.1 million in FY 25. During FY 25, handle, or total amount wagered, equaled \$5.52 billion, an approximate increase of \$780 million. Online wagers accounted for 98% of all wagers made in FY 25.

Passed during the 2025 legislative session, Public Law 184 requires the Commission to contract with an independent, qualified gaming industry research firm to conduct a study to identify and assess the top two (2) regions in the state where an owner's license to operate a casino may be located. Spectrum Gaming Group was selected following a public bidding. The study must be completed no later than November 1, 2025, and will be posted to the Commission's website and submitted to the State Budget Committee.

In addition, with the passage of Public Law 74, qualified veteran and fraternal charitable organizations will be allowed to offer electronic pull tabs beginning on July 1, 2025. Needless to stay, Commission staff will be busy implementing both measures during FY 26, along with its traditional duties.

FY 2025 TAX OVERVIEW


In FY2025, gaming and sports wagering operations in Indiana generated \$574,801,318 in wagering tax, \$49,868,770 in supplemental wagering tax, and \$49,137,348 in sports wagering tax for a total of \$673,807,436. As of June 30, 2025, \$18,616,189,510 in Wagering, Supplemental Wagering, and Sports Wagering Tax had been reported since inception.





MBE/WBE UTILIZATION

Disparity Study

Statute requires the Commission to establish annual goals for the use of minority and women-owned enterprises (M/WBE). These goals must be derived from a statistical analysis of utilization study of casino contracting and purchases. Such an analysis, also called a disparity study, must be updated every five years.

In keeping with its statutory mandate, an update of the Commission's study was completed in November 2022. The Indiana University Public Policy Institute completed the study on our behalf, examining the contracting and purchasing practices of Indiana's casinos from 2017 through 2022. Based upon actual purchase data provided by the casinos and audited by Commission staff, the study period reviewed over \$1.7 billion in spending on goods and services.

In addition to a review of purchasing, also called utilization, a disparity study must also seek to establish capacity, which is a measure of all firms ready, willing, and able to provide goods and services to Indiana's riverboat casinos. The capacity estimate derived from the study is below.









VEP Statistics

There were 6,637 active members from forty (40) different states in the Voluntary Exclusion Program (VEP) as of June 30, 2025. 4,672 members were previously enrolled for a one or five year term, and have since removed themselves from the VEP, for a total of 11,309 enrollments over the life of the program. In fiscal year 2025, sixty (60) forfeitures were approved by the Commission, and resulted in approximately \$31,000 in forfeitures.




Member State






Member Exclusion Length

Member Age







ISRP Statistics

Pursuant to Indiana Code 4-38, the Internet Self-Restriction Program (ISRP) was implemented on September 1, 2019. ISRP only applies to mobile sports wagering. Mobile sports wagering is defined as sports wagering conducted through computers or mobile or interactive devices and accepted in the state of Indiana through an online sports wagering system approved by the IGC. To date, four hundred thirty-five (435) individuals have signed up for ISRP; with sixty-three (63) individuals removing themself bringing the active total enrollments to three hundred seventy-two (372). The graphs here display the program participants, as categorized by age, gender, home state and length of exclusion.


Member Gender




Member State
