# **COMPLAINT FOR MEDICAL MALPRACTICE**

COMES NOW the Plaintiff, ALBERT TERPSTRA, by his attorneys, PAVICH LAW GROUP, P.C., and complaining of the Defendants, DAVID A. STEWART, M.D. and VSEVOLOD B. TIKHOMIROV, M.D., states as follows:

# FACTS APPLICABLE TO ALL COUNTS

- 1. On October 26, 2020, and thereafter, ALBERT TERPSTRA was a patient pursuant to I.C. 24-18-1-1 *et seq.* of Defendant, DAVID A. STEWART M.D., hereafter "DR. STEWART."
- 2. At all times stated herein, DR. STEWART was a physician specializing in cardiology and interventional cardiology, was licensed to practice medicine in the State of Indiana, and was a "qualified" health provider pursuant to 34-18-1-1 *et seq*.
- 3. On October 28, 2020, and thereafter, ALBERT TERPSTRA was a patient pursuant to I.C. 24-18-1-1 *et seq.* of Defendant VSEVOLOD B. TIKHOMIROV M.D., hereafter "DR. TIKHOMIROV."
- 4. At all times stated herein, DR. TIKHOMIROV was a physician specializing in cardiothoracic/vascular surgery, was licensed to practice medicine in the State of Indiana, was a

"qualified" health provider pursuant to 34-18-1-1 *et seq.*, and acted individually and as Agent of CCNI.

- 5. On October 26, 2020, ALBERT TERPSTRA was admitted to Community Hospital under the care of admitting provider, DR. STEWART, and was diagnosed with an acute saddle pulmonary embolism with cor pulmonale and deep vein thrombosis.
- 6. On October 27, 2020, DR. STEWART performed a pulmonary angiogram and insertion of EKOS catheters into ALBERT TERPSTRA's right and left pulmonary arteries.
- 7. During the course of the EKOS procedure, DR. STEWART noted that a tip of one of the venous access sheaths had sheared off and was unable to be located via fluoroscopic imaging.
- 8. On October 28, 2020, at 10:11am, DR. STEWART ordered a CT scan to locate the sheared-off sheath.
- 9. On October 28, 2020, at 10:26am, the intact sheath and EKOS Catheter were removed.
- 10. At 10:29am, DR. STEWART ordered that a CT be performed after ALBERT TERPSTRA completed four hours of bedrest following the 10:26am sheath and catheter removal.
- 11. On October 28, 2020, at 4:13pm, ALBERT TERPSTRA underwent a CT scan that disclosed the portion of the sheath that had been sheared off, measuring 7cm, which was seen in the right external iliac vein extending into the right common femoral vein.
  - 12. DR. STEWART reviewed the October 28 CT findings at the time of interpretation.
- 13. DR. STEWART then referred ALBERT TERPSTRA for consultation with cardiovascular surgery for removal of the sheath.

- 14. On October 28, 2020, at or about 5:52pm, DR. TIKHOMIROV evaluated ALBERT TERPSTRA and planned to perform a right groin exploration, femoral cut-down, and extraction of the retained intravascular sheath on October 29, 2020.
- 15. On October 28, 2020, at or about 5:52pm, DR. STEWART was present on the floor, was aware of the planned October 29 extraction, and advised the staff that it was acceptable for ALBERT TERPSTRA to ambulate to the bathroom.
- 16. On October 27, 2020, and thereafter, DR. STEWART knew of the risk that the sheared-off catheter could migrate within the vasculature.
- 17. On October 28, 2020, DR. TIKHOMIROV knew of the risk that the sheared-off catheter could migrate within the vasculature.
- 18. On October 29, 2020, at 1:43pm, DR. TIKHOMIROV performed the femoral cutdown upon ALBERT TERPSTRA and the sheared-off catheter was not found.
- 19. A CT scan performed on October 29, 2020, at 4:35pm, showed that the 7cm catheter had migrated into ALBERT TERPSTRA's right ventricle.
- 20. On October 30, 2020, DR. STEWART unsuccessfully performed percutaneous intravascular attempts to remove the catheter from ALBERT TERPSTRA's heart.
- 21. On October 30, 2020, ALBERT TERPSTRA underwent a sternotomy and cardiopulmonary bypass surgery that resulted in successful removal of the migrated catheter from within his heart.
- 22. This matter was presented to a Medical Review Panel on December 17, 2024 and July 15, 2025. Plaintiff's counsel received a certified copy of the Medical Review Panel Opinion from Chairman G. Anthony Bertig on September 11, 2025, confirming that the Panel had convened

and rendered a unanimous opinion, thus satisfying the requirements of I.C. 34-18-8-4. (See Opinion of Medical Review Panel, attached hereto as Exhibit A.)

### COUNT I - NEGLIGENCE v. DAVID A. STEWART, M.D.

- 1-22. Plaintiff hereby incorporates allegations contained in paragraphs 1-22 as if fully set forth herein.
- 23. On October 27, 2020 and thereafter, DR. STEWART was negligent and fell below the standard of care in one or more of the following ways:
  - a. Failed to timely order tests to determine the location of the sheared-off portion of the sheath;
  - b. Failed to see that ordered tests to locate the sheath were timely performed;
  - Failed to timely order a consultation with cardiovascular surgery for removal of the sheared-off sheath;
  - d. Failed to timely remove or see that the sheared-off portion of the sheath was timely removed by a qualified physician prior to its migration into the heart;
  - e. On October 28, 2020, permitted ALBERT TERPSTRA to be up and ambulate to the bathroom.
- 24. As a result of the forgoing negligence of DR. STEWART, as outlined above, the sheared-off portion of the catheter migrated into ALBERT TERPSTRA's right ventricle, requiring an endovascular procedure and sternotomy with cardiopulmonary bypass to remove it, causing significant past and future pain and suffering, past and future disability, disfigurement, development of a cardiac arrhythmia condition, and past and future medical expenses.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, ALBERT TERPSTRA, asks for damages against Defendant, DAVID A. STEWART, M.D., as are reasonable in the premises, the costs of this action, judgment interest and for all other proper relief.

### COUNT II – NEGLIGENCE v. VSEVOLOD B. TIKHOMIROV, M.D.

- 1-22. Plaintiff hereby incorporates allegations contained in paragraphs 1-22 as if fully set forth herein.
- 25. On October 28, 2020, and thereafter, DR. TIKHOMIROV was negligent and fell below the standard of care in that he failed to timely take ALBERT TERPSTRA to surgery and remove the sheared-off sheath prior to its migration into ALBERT TERPSTRA's heart.
- 26. As a direct and proximate result of the foregoing negligence of DR. TIKHOMIROV as outlined above, the sheared-off portion of the catheter migrated into ALBERT TERPSTRA's right ventricle, requiring an endovascular procedure and sternotomy with cardiopulmonary bypass to remove it, causing significant past and future pain and suffering, past and future disability, disfigurement, development of a cardiac arrhythmia condition, and past and future medical expenses.
- 27. On October 29, 2020, DR. TIKHOMIROV was negligent and fell below the standard of care in that he failed to order a CT scan to determine the location of the sheath before commencing the right groin exploration/femoral cut-down.
- 28. As a direct and proximate result of the foregoing negligence of DR. TIKHOMIROV as outlined above, ALBERT TERPSTRA underwent surgery that was no longer indicated, suffered unnecessary pain and suffering, and incurred past and future medical expenses.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, ALBERT TERPSTRA, asks for damages against Defendant, VSEVOLOD B. TIKHOMIROV, M.D., as are reasonable in the premises, the costs of this action, judgment interest, and for all other proper relief.
