Purpose

This presentation presents projected school boundary reconfiguration for the 2021-22 school year. Boundary reconfiguration needs to occur in order to

- Balance enrollment of students at secondary levels
- Illustrate new secondary school boundaries

Boundary Shifts

- Big Shift: Edison Elementary school boundary was split into 2 portions in order to create balanced enrollment for secondary middle and high schools
 - No shift in current school boundary for any elementary school
 - Edison Elementary is split into Edison North and Edison South
 - Edison North feeds into Hammond Central cohort whereas Edison South feeds into Morton cohort
- Former Clark MS/HS school boundary is merged into the former Hammond High boundary and current Eggers Middle boundary
- Former Gavit MS/HS school boundary is merged into the current boundary of Morton High and Scott Middle, except for Edison split






Edison El Current Boundary




Edison El Boundary Split




Current Boundary of Clark MS & Eggers MS




Current Boundary of Clark HS & Hammond High

Projected Reconfigured Secondary Boundary

- Boundaries for Eggers and Central / Scott and Morton are the same
- Hammond Central boundary is determined by

Eggers MS + Clark MS + Edison North = Eggers boundary '21


Hammond HS + Clark HS + Edison North = Hammond Central '21

- Scott Ms and Morton boundary are determined by


Scott MS + Gavit MS + Edison South = Scott Ms '21

Morton HS + Gavit HS + Edison South = Morton HS '21

Summary

- Boundary shifts impacts for secondary schools only
- Big shift is Edison Elementary being split to balance enrollment at secondary levels
- Boundary Shifts illustrate schools of attendance for the students at the former Clark MS/HS and Gavit MS/HS
- HAPA course offerings between both high schools could be used to create further balance at the high school level
