Dear Senator Tallian and Representative Boy:

Thank you for your January 6, 2020 letter regarding the ongoing sand erosion along the Lake Michigan shoreline in Porter and LaPorte counties. Governor Holcomb asked me to look into the situation and respond to you. A disaster or emergency declaration will not provide any additional state or federal resources or relief at this time.


The Indiana Department of Homeland Security has been in contact with the Federal Emergency Management Agency about the potential to access federal emergency funds; however, no such funds would be available under the provisions of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 through 5207) and the regulations governing federal disaster assistance located at 44 CFR 206. To date, we are unaware of any loss of infrastructure (i.e. roads, bridges, public utilities, etc.) which would qualify for public assistance funding from federal or state disaster relief programs.

As you correctly stated, our office, along with several other state agencies, have been monitoring this situation for some time and have been in touch with local, state, and federal elected officials and federal agencies. Similar shoreline erosion issues exist in Michigan, which also has not issued a state disaster declaration or requested a declaration from FEMA at this time.

We will remain in contact with local and federal officials and agencies about funding and resources available for preventative measures which may provide some short-term relief from the erosion, but also more permanent, long-term mitigation projects.

Thank you both for your letter and for keeping our office apprised of the issues facing our lakeshore in northern Indiana.
