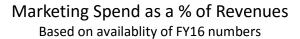

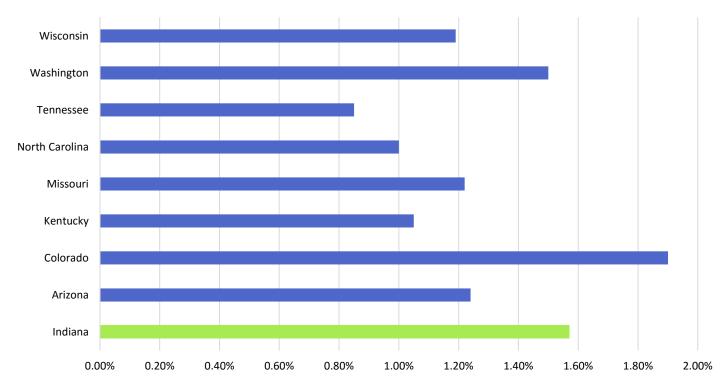

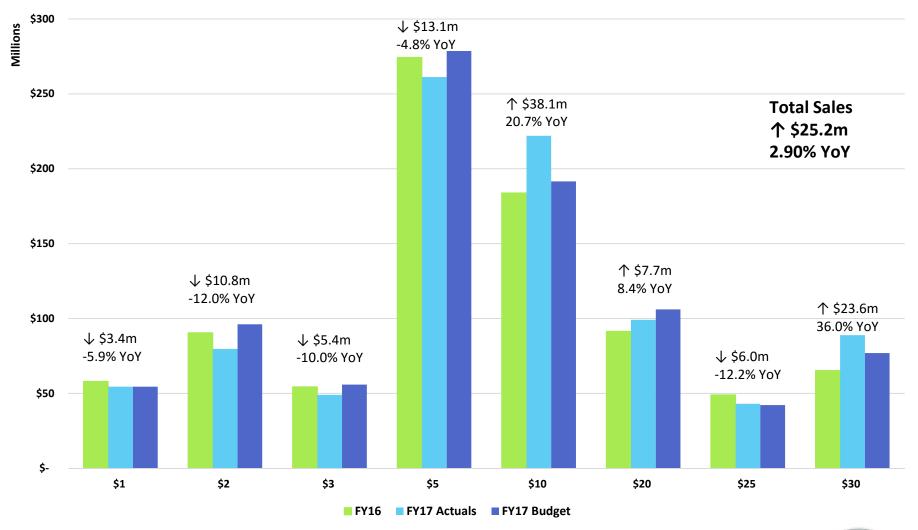


Total Sales and PNI





Scratch-off Sales YoY



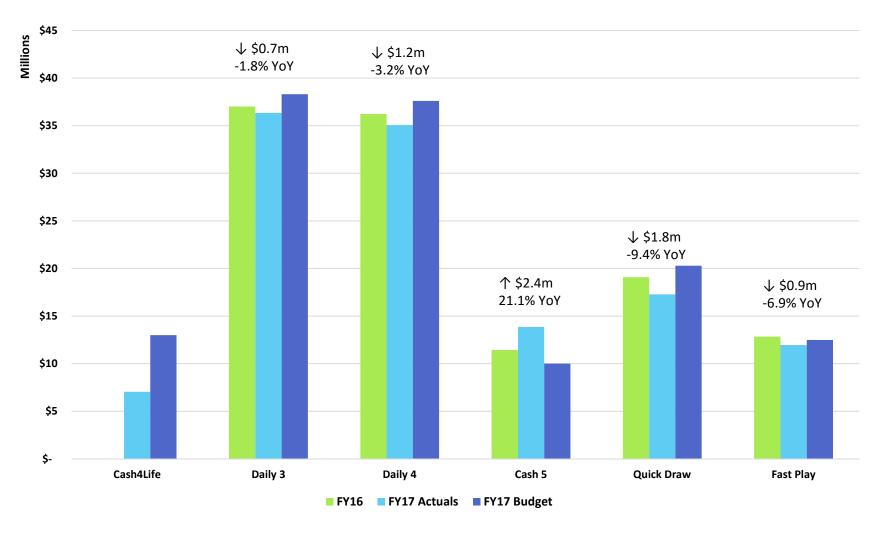
Jackpot Sales YoY

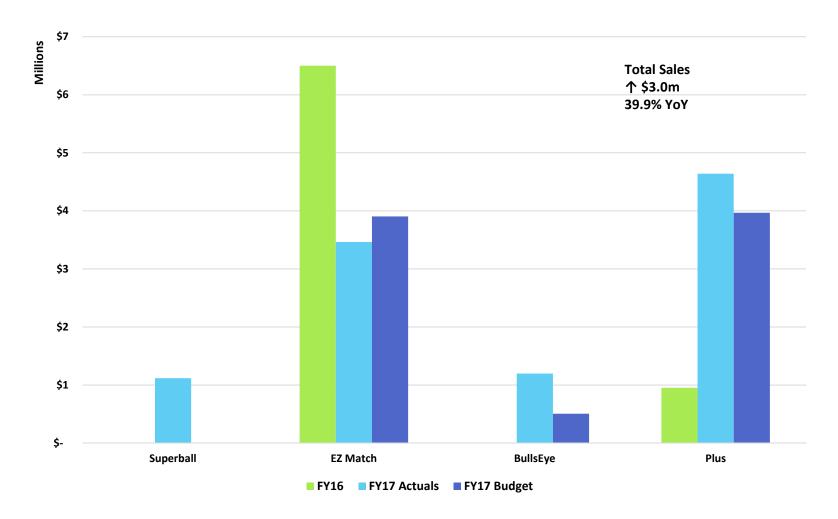


Non-Jackpot Sales YoY

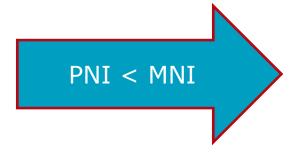
Draw Add-on Sales YoY

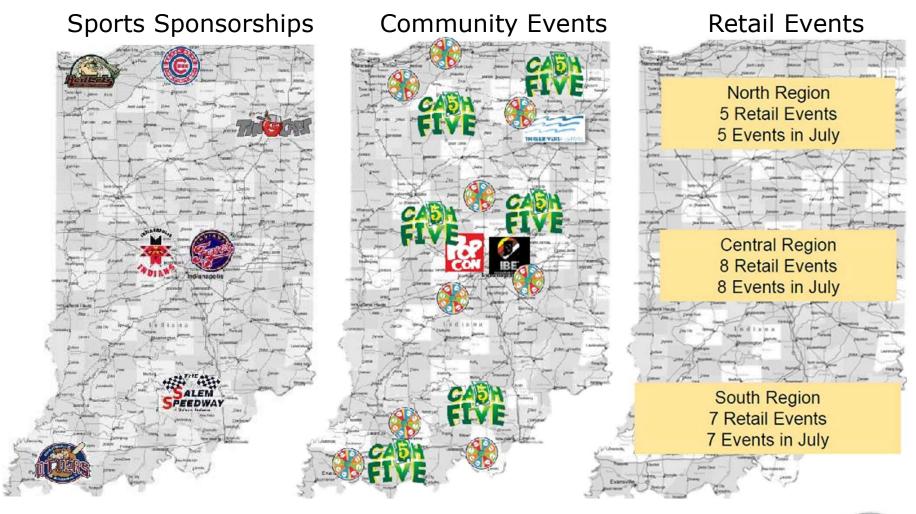

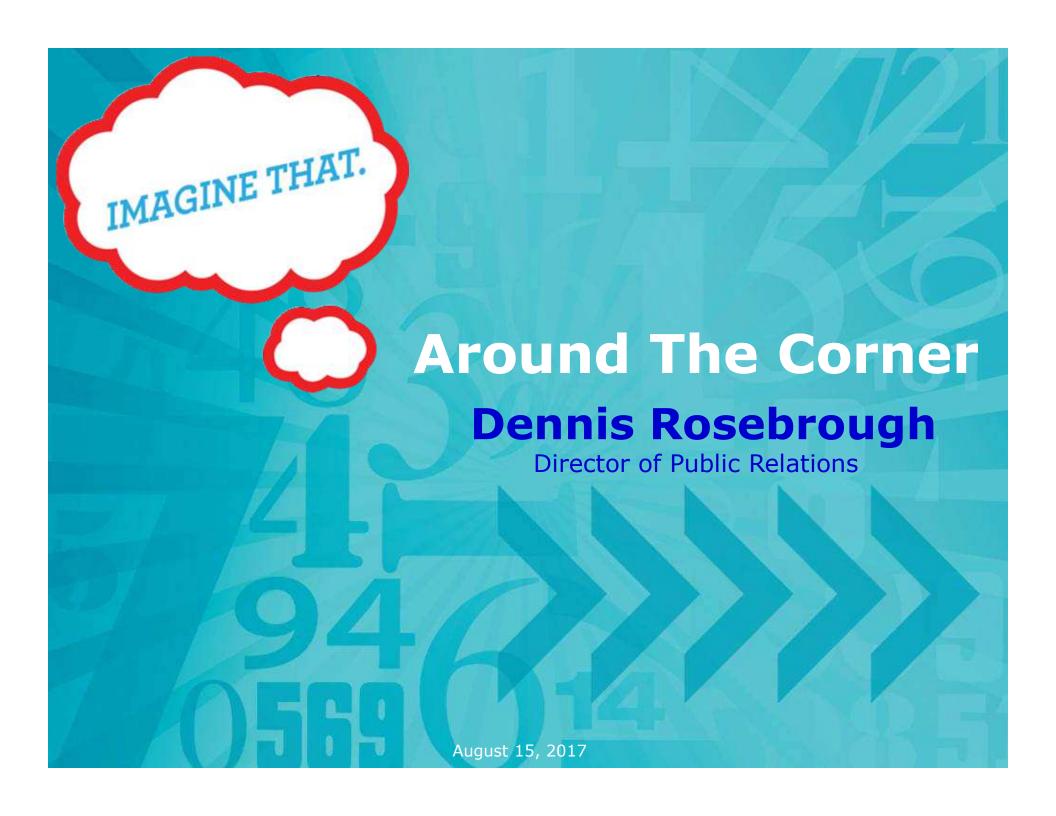
Indiana State Fair - Truck Giveaway

 - Sarah Taylor to draw the winning ticket





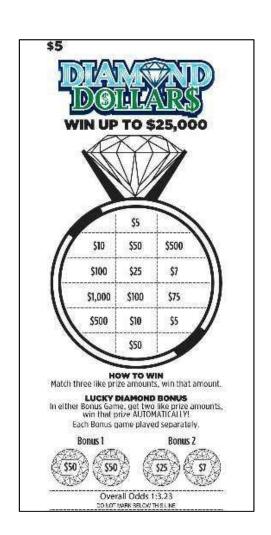


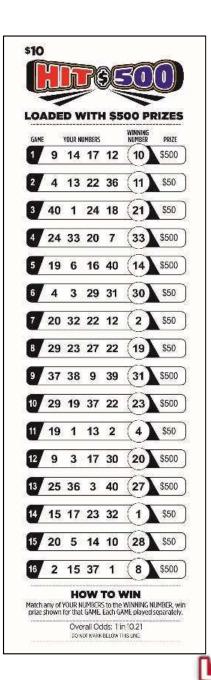

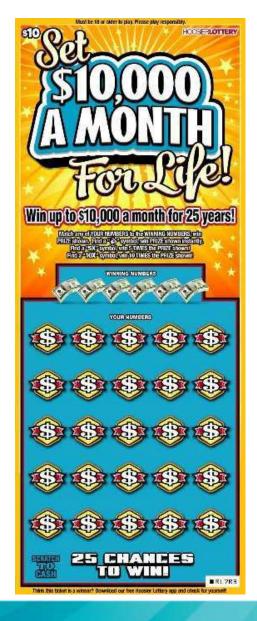
