Citations Affected: IC 36-1-30.

Synopsis: Local government budgets. Provides that a local government unit may not reduce its annual budget for public safety, police, or fire services for a fiscal year by an amount in excess of the levy reduction by the unit for the fiscal year unless the unit is subject to a revenue shortfall for the fiscal year.

Effective: July 1, 2021.



A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-1-30 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS
2 A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2021]:

4 **Chapter 30. Local Government Unit Budget Reduction**
5 **Limitation**

6 **Sec. 1. A unit may not reduce its annual budget for public**
7 **safety, police, or fire services for a fiscal year by an amount in**
8 **excess of the levy reduction by the unit for the fiscal year unless the**
9 **unit is subject to a revenue shortfall for the fiscal year.**
