

Consideration of Resolution 25-01

- 65 IAC 8-2-4 outlines a process for a person who, although unable to produce a winning ticket, is able to produce evidence sufficient to establish the validity of that players prize claim;
- Mr. Johnson has presented sufficient evidence to show that he was the rightful owner of a winning draw ticket identified by the Lottery's terminal system as a \$20,000 winner;
- Mr. Johnson's claim and evidence has been fully investigated by the Security Division of the Hoosier Lottery resulting in a recommendation that Mr. Johnson be paid the \$20,000 prize he won
- The Director of the Hoosier Lottery has reviewed Mr. Johnson's claim, is satisfied that
 the validity of the claim has been established, and the Lottery's Security Director has
 prepared a written recommendation that payment of the prize claim be authorized by
 the Commission.
