

BLACKOUT LICENSE PLATE FACT SHEET

- As of August 8, 2025, the Indiana Blackout plate is available for an additional fee of \$45.00.
- If you choose a Personalized License Plate (PLP) message for your new Blackout plate, a separate \$45.00 fee applies.
- The fee(s) will be due upon initial registration and all subsequent annual renewals.
- You don't have to wait until your current registration expires to purchase the Blackout plate. A **\$9.50** replacement plate fee will be added on top of the other standard fees listed above

You must visit a branch to complete this transaction. It cannot be completed online or at a kiosk.

- Only license plates issued by the Indiana BMV are legal for use on a vehicle. Any third-party
 company or website that claims to "print a plate" or sell a version of the Blackout Plate is not
 authorized to do so.
- The Blackout plate is a standalone design and **cannot be combined** with any other specialty plate types. Therefore, the Blackout plate cannot merge styles, graphics, or design elements from different plates. Disability Blackout plates will be available at a later date.
- The plate is available to Indiana residents registering a passenger motor vehicle, light truck (less than 11,000lbs), motorcycle, or RV.

Why Blackout?

- Sparked by the interest of similar plates in other states, the Blackout plate has quickly captured the attention of Hoosier drivers.
- The Blackout plate pairs well with many vehicle makes, models, and colors.
- Its modern, minimalist design is viewed as a stylish alternative to traditional plates.

How to Purchase:

• Online at myBMV.com or at a BMV Connect kiosk as a new registration or renewal transaction.

If you're renewing a standard passenger plate (Covered Bridge) online or at a kiosk, and your plate is a low number or a Personalized License Plate (PLP), switching to a blackout plate will result in a new plate number being issued.

To keep your low number or PLP when transferring to a blackout plate, you must visit a branch in person to amend your registration.

• At any BMV branch
