TURNING OPPORTUNITY INTO ACHIEVEMENT FOR PAYSON STUDENTS



Aspire Arizona Foundation continues to prove that education elevates everyone. With a mission to create higher education opportunities for students in Payson and Rim Country, Aspire helps local students take meaningful steps toward college and career success.

Through its Dual Credit Program, Aspire provides scholarship funding for high school students to take college courses while attending Payson Unified School District schools. Since fall 2016, Aspire has helped 737 Payson students earn 10,411 college credits, saving families thousands in tuition costs while giving students a strong head start.

In total, Aspire students have completed 3,394 college classes, including 1,272 English, 1,172 math, and 622 science courses. 55% of those classes were completed with an A, while 24% earned a B. Nearly half of participating students have completed six to fourteen college credits, while 34% have earned fifteen to thirty or more credits before graduating high school. These accomplishments reflect academic success, confidence, discipline, and belief in what is possible.
