


Other Benefits to the Town

- Comprehensive Analytics
 - Roadway usage data
 - Vehicle Type
 - Traffic Volume
 - Peak hours/days/months/locations
- Data Can be shared with Streets or Community Development
 - Limited to roadway usage analysis
 - No criminal information or PII will be accessible by non-LE personnel
