

RESOLUTION NO. 20-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN CLEMENTE, CALIFORNIA SUPPLEMENTING ITS PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY REGARDING NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, as empowered by California Government Code section 8630 and San Clemente Municipal Code chapter 8.12, the City Council adopted a resolution proclaiming a local emergency regarding novel coronavirus (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, the imminent and proximate threat of introduction of COVID-19 in the City of San Clemente continues to threaten the safety and health of City residents; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes, with this resolution, to supplement its proclamation to further address the local emergency; and

WHEREAS, this resolution will further assist in a coordinated public health response to reduce transmission and illness severity, provide assistance to health care providers, coordinate and mitigate public services that may be disrupted from this emergency, and mitigate any other effects of this emergency on the citizens of the City; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of a local emergency will assist in a coordinated public health response to reduce transmission and illness severity, provide assistance to health care providers, coordinate and mitigate public services that may be disrupted from this emergency, and mitigate any other effects of this emergency on the citizens of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Clemente, California resolves as follows:

Section 1. Proclamation

Again, pursuant to California Government Code section 8630 and San Clemente Municipal Code chapter 8.12, the City Council hereby finds and proclaims a local emergency caused by conditions or threatened conditions of COVID-19 in San Clemente, which constitutes an extreme peril of health and safety of persons within the territorial limits of the City.

Section 2. Duration

Again, the local emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the City Council.

Section 3. Parking Lots and Street Parking

The Council hereby ratifies the Interim City Manager's March 25, 2020 decision to close to the public until further notice all City-owned beachfront parking lots and the San Clemente Municipal Pier.

Parking lot closures include all metered spaces in the following locations:

- North Beach Parking (except that parking for Metrolink users and commuters will remain available at the designated location in the north end of the lot),
- Linda Lane Parking Lot,
- Pier Bowl & Parque Del Mar Parking Lots, and
- T-Street Parking.

Section 4. Mobile Testing for COVID-19 for residents of 92673 and 92672 Zip Codes

Mobile testing for COVID-19 for residents with 92673 and 92672 zip codes is permitted in the Regional Medical Facilities 1 (RMF1) Zone for the duration of this local emergency.

Section 5. Powers of Government

During the existence of said local emergency, the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be those prescribed by state law, ordinances, and resolutions of this City of San Clemente.

Section 6. Certification

The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
