Full Freeway Closure on I-5 at El Toro Road & Alicia Parkway May 16, 2022 – May 17, 2022

Orange County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in partnership with the Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) will be relocating overhead transmission lines at Los Alisos Boulevard (half way between Alicia Parkway and El Toro Road) on Monday and Tuesday nights (**May 16th and May 17th**) from **11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.** Please note that this work requires **closures in both directions** of Interstate 5 (I-5) at Alicia Parkway going northbound and at El Toro Road going southbound.

Message signs will be located leading up to the closure to advise motorists to take alternate routes.

- **Detour 1:** Southbound I-5 off-ramp to El Toro Rd, straight to Paseo De Valencia make a left on Alicia Pkwy, and a right to I-5 southbound on-ramp.
- **Detour 2:** Northbound I-5 off-ramp to Alicia Pkwy, right on Alicia Pkwy make a left on Muirlands Blvd, another left on El Toro Rd, and a right on I-5 northbound on-ramp.
- Please obey all posted signs and traffic instructions for the safety of all workers and motorists. Detour map attached below.

Caltrans appreciates the public's patience while we perform this work. Electronic Changeable Messages Signs will notify drivers of the closure. The work schedule is subject to change due to traffic incidents, weather, availability of equipment and/or materials, and/or construction-related issues.
