### **City of Dana Point Celebrates Opening of Revitalized Shipwreck Park**

**Dana Point, CA (February 15, 2022)** -- The City of Dana Point celebrated the completion of a major renovation of its Shipwreck Park. A small park located at the corner of Golden Lantern and La Cresta Drive in Lantern Village, Shipwreck Park is a beloved neighborhood park used by the local community, known for its most prominent playground structure feature in the form of a shipwreck. The renovation, initiated in August of 2021, addressed an aging park and playground.

The city implemented a number of major improvements as part of the renovation including a new playground with rubberized surfacing, new sidewalks, benches, tables, new stairways, new fencing and gates along Golden Lantern, as well as new landscaping and irrigation. The park was also converted to recycled water use during the renovation.

The City Council celebrated the reopening with a ribbon cutting on February 15, 2022.
