Probable Cause Statement

On 3-26-18 at approximately 2256 hours, the Superior Police Department was dispatched to [REDACTED] Superior AZ for two unresponsive children. The reporting person identified as Brittany Velasquez the mother of the children was reporting that she had found her two children in a vehicle in front of her house. The children were identified as 2 year old [REDACTED] and 9 month old [REDACTED]. Brittany was advising her two children were not breathing and that they both had blood coming from their mouths. The Superior fire Department was also dispatched to the scene but lives saving efforts were not successful. The children were both pronounced dead at the scene.

Brittany was interviewed regarding her involvement in this case as she is the mother and the last person to see her children alive. Brittany stated that she placed her children in [REDACTED]'s car at approximately 0930 hours on 3-26-18. Brittany stated she took her children to [REDACTED]'s house and dropped them off before going to work. Brittany claims that she worked all day and came home at approximately 2300 hours. When Brittany returned home she went back into [REDACTED]'s vehicle and found both children deceased. Brittany claims that this is [REDACTED]'s fault and that she believed [REDACTED] brought the kids back over to her residence put them in the car and left them there.

[REDACTED] that Brittany stated watched the kids and who is responsible for this incident was contacted. [REDACTED] stated there were no arrangements made by Brittany for her to watch the children on 3-26-18. There was a confrontation call conducted with Brittany and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she had no idea what was happening and did not know what Brittany was talking about. It was apparent that Brittany was attempting to place the blame onto somebody else for this incident.

Further on in the interview with Brittany she was certain that she dropped the children off at [REDACTED]. There was no proof that Brittany actually dropped the children off. It is known that the kids spent several hours in the vehicle as there was condensation on the inside windows of the vehicle and the children were cold to the touch and rigor mortis had already set in. The children were also wearing the same clothing that they were seen in when they were placed into the car. The children were also strapped into their car seats as they would be when they are placed into the car. Brittany was the last person to see the children alive at 0930 hours on 3-26-18 and she was the person to find the children on 3-26-18 at 2256 hours.

The grandmother of Brittany was also interviewed related to this incident. [REDACTED] stated she saw Brittany put the children in her own car which is Brittany's car and left the house at 0930 hours. [REDACTED] stated Brittany is never allowed to drive her vehicle [REDACTED]'s vehicle at any time. This was also an inconsistency in Brittany's story. Brittany's vehicle was not even capable at the time of this investigation to put car seats in due to moving boxes and other items in her vehicle. [REDACTED] stated that her vehicle never left the house all day.
