# POLAND

Located in Central Europe, for more than 1,000 years Poland has survived an almost constant battle for its boundaries. The present borders were set after World War II ended in 1945. Its landscape varies from sandy beaches on the coast to the snow-covered mountains of the Carpathian and Sudeten Mountains.

On Sept. 1, 1939, Poland was attacked by Nazi Germany, led by Adolf Hitler. By 1941, Germany seized all of Poland. During the six years of war and Nazi occupation, combat, execution and concentration camps resulted in the deaths of 6 million Polish

people; half were Jewish. At the end of the war, Poland was forced to accept a communist government, and millions of Poles were forced to resettle.

The European bison, called wisent, are the largest European mammals. Habitat destruction decimated their numbers. By 1919, no bison existed in the wild. The animal was reintroduced to the wild using animals bred in captivity.



Poland has 23 national parks, 1,269 nature preserves and a hundred bird sanctuaries.


Poland has many unique customs: September and early winter are thought to be the best time to get married. St. Nicholas (Santa Claus) delivers presents twice — on Dec. 6 and on Christmas Eve. When you turn 18 years old, you become an adult and traditionally now celebrate your name day, not your birthday.

Dyed eggs called **pisanki** are an Easter tradition.

Going mushrooming in the fall is a popular family activity. Children are taught how to distinguish an edible mushroom from a poisonous one early on.

Some Polish men still kiss women on the hand as a formal greeting. It is considered to be a symbol of deep respect, sympathy and friendship.

About 70% of the world's amber originated in Poland.
