The South African flag was adopted in 1994. The colorful flag is symbolic of the long journey from disparity to unity of the South African people.

In a word

South Africa has 12 official languages and many unofficial ones. The official languages are isiZulu, Afrikaans, English, isiXhosa, siSwati, Sesotho, Xitsonga, Sepedi, isiNdebele, Setswana, Tshivenda and sign language.

The country's nickname is the **Rainbow Nation** for its many diverse cultures.

A bit of history

There is a cave near Johannesburg called the Sterkfontein where archaeologists have found some of the earliest human fossils ever discovered.

About 24,000 years ago, tribes of hunter-gatherers moved into the region. Ancestors of these ancient people live near the **Kalahari Desert** in the northwest.

The British took control of the Dutch colony at Cape Town in 1806. Almost 100 years later, four British colonies in the region united, creating South Africa. Laws were established that separated white and Black South Africans, a practice of **segregation** called **apartheid**. These unfair laws led to generations of conflict and unrest.

In 1990, after 27 years in prison, **Nelson Mandela** (head of the anti-apartheid African National Congress) was freed. He became the first democratically elected president of free South Africa in 1994.

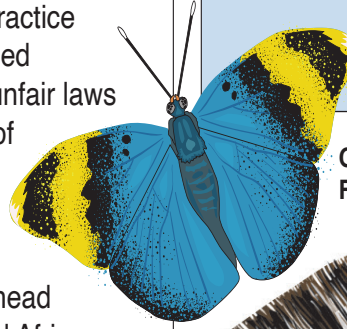
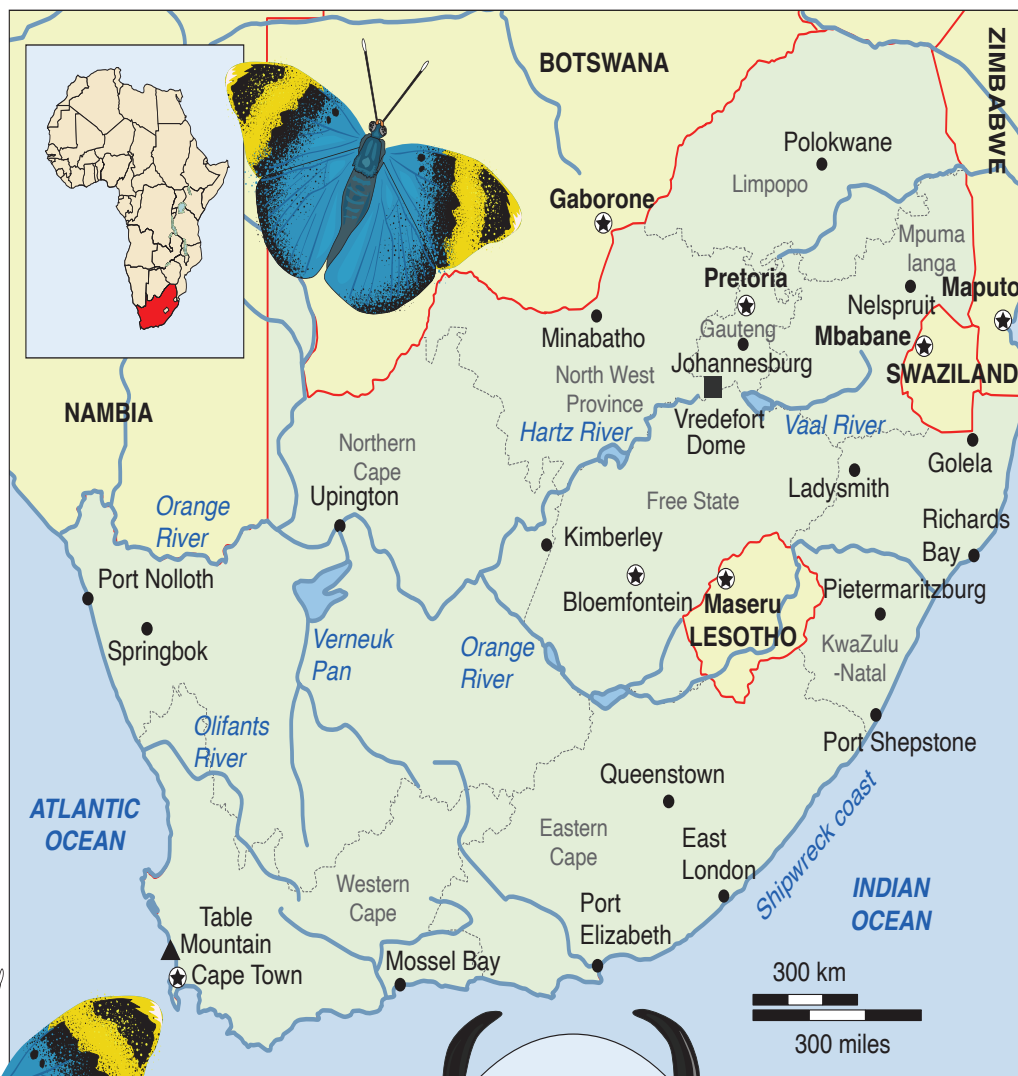

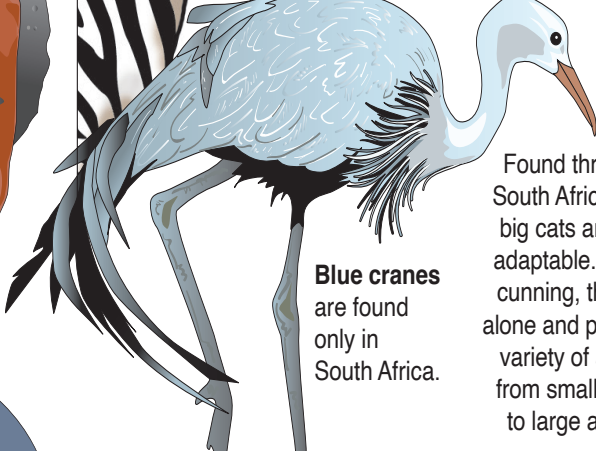
Springbok

Found throughout South Africa, these big cats are highly adaptable. Shy but cunning, they hunt alone and prey on a variety of animals, from small rodents to large antelope.



The **giant protea** or **king protea** is the national flower of South Africa. It has a very large, artichoke-shaped bloom and is sometimes used in wedding bouquets. It flowers in late spring.

Table Mountain is one of the oldest mountains on the planet.

South Africa's drinking water is rated third-best in the world.

The nation of **Lesotho** is entirely surrounded by South Africa. It is one of only three nations in the world enclosed by another country.

There are more than 2,000 shipwrecks off the coast.

The oldest remains of modern humans were discovered in South Africa and are more than 160,000 years old.
