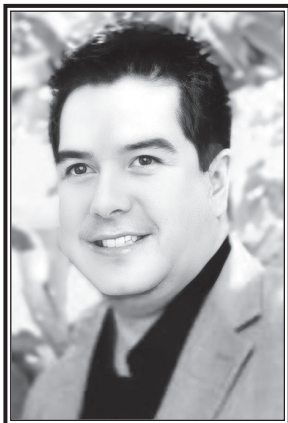


Ralph Kevin Montijo
