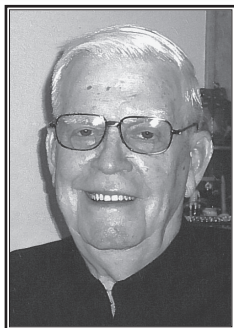


William “Bill” H. Faulstick
