The artists who draw/write Manga characters and comics are called Manga-ka.

Manga is considered part of the otaku (nerd) culture in Japan, and it is celebrated as part of the nation's identity.

Manga can refer to all kinds of cartooning, comics and animation. The term "Manga" was first used in 1798, to describe the picture book Shiji no Yukikai (Four Seasons) by Santō Kyōden.


漫画 are the two kanji (symbols) used to write the word Manga in Japanese. The first kanji 渴 is called man, and and translates as "pictures." Together these symbols represent Manga.

Check out some of these Manga titles for young readers: Hikaru no Go by Yumi Hotta and Takeshi Obata, Barakamon by Satsuki Yoshino, Yotsuba&! by Kyohiko Azuma.

Manga is an art form and narrative that can trace its roots to 12th-century Japan. Some manga art, graphic novels and comics have evolved into anime and cosplay. Manga is popular with readers of all ages and has been translated into many languages. The art form has a unique and beautiful aesthetic combined with a variety of compelling stories, from romance and history to science fiction and fantasy.

## How to draw a cute Manga animal

Manga art can be incredibly realistic or cartoonish, but Manga characters almost always have large eyes, small mouths, flat faces and odd-colored hair. Below are some drawing tips to get you started creating your own Manga character.



## Did you know?

Manga is pronounced maw-nnnn-gah. In Japanese, it is actually three syllables, although the middle "N" is spoken very quickly.

Japanese Manga is read from the right to the left, the opposite of traditional Western books.

A Manga can have a mix of black and white pages and others with color.

After World War II, Japan was introduced to American comics and cartoons, which influenced the Manga styles of the 1950s.

There are different kinds of Manga in Japan. Shônen is Manga, pronounced show-joe. Kodomo is children's Manga,
