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Three D91 Board of Trustee Seats Up For Election On Nov. 5 **Declarations of Candidacy Must Be Filed By Sept 6**

The Zone 3, Zone 4 and Zone 5 seats on the Idaho Falls School Board are up for election on Nov. 5, but interested candidates must file their Declarations of Candidacy by 5 p.m. Friday, Sept. 6, 2019.

Candidates must reside in the zone they wish to represent, but when elected, they will represent the district as a whole. Zone 3 includes the areas around Theresa Bunker, Edgemont, Longfellow, Linden Park and Sunnyside. Zone 4 includes the areas around Erickson, Linden Park, Hawthorne and Idaho Falls High School. Zone 5 includes the neighborhoods around Hawthorne, Longfellow, Sunnyside and Taylorview. More detailed zone descriptions are available at www.ifschools.org.

The Board of Trustees plays a critical role in any school district. The board's duties include:

- Interpreting the community's educational needs and aspirations, and then formulating policies to meet them
- Providing leadership, support and resources so the school system's goals and objectives can be effectively carried out
- Promoting management of the school system in accordance with Board policy
- Maintaining two-way communication with stakeholders served by the schools
- Evaluating the effectiveness of current programs as they relate to the district's mission

Interested candidates must complete a Declaration of Candidacy and file it by 5 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 6, 2019, at the district office, 690 John Adams Parkway. Before a declaration is submitted candidates must collect the signatures of at least five school electors who reside in the zone they wish to represent, and an official at the Bonneville County Elections office must certify those signatures.

Candidate packets are available at the Idaho Falls School District Office, 690 John Adams Parkway. The office is open from 7:30 am to 4:30 pm. The election is scheduled for Nov. 5, 2019. Only those residing in each zone can vote for the candidate running to represent that zone. More information is available at www.ifschools.org.
