Hatin as the complainant herein, employed by the Warren County Sheriff's Office at 1400 State Route 9 Lake George New York 12845, accuse David J. Decker, the above named defendant with having committed felony of Grand Larceny in the Second Degree in violation of Section 155.40 Subdivision 1 of the Penal Law of the State of New York.

That on or about the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 2012 at 1 Lower Amherst Street the offices of the Lake Champlain-Lake George Regional Planning Board in the Village of Lake George, Warren County, State of New York, the defendant did, upon information and belief, knowingly, intentionally, and unlawfully steal property with a value exceeding fifty thousand dollars.

To wit: The above named defendant did knowingly, intentionally and unlawfully steal more than \$69,156 in United State Department of Agriculture grant funds by fraud.

Decker, the above named defendant with having committed felony of Offering a False Instrument for Filing in the First Degree in violation of Section 175.35 of the Penal Law of the State of New York.

That on or about the 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2012, at 1 Lower Amherst Street the offices of the Lake Champlain-Lake George Regional Planning Board in the Village of Lake George, Warren County, State of New York, the defendant did, upon information and belief, knowingly, intentionally, and unlawfully offer or present a written instrument that contained a false statement or false information to a public office, public servant, public authority or public benefit corporation of the state, knowing such written instrument contained such a false statement or false information, and with the intent to defraud the state or any political subdivision, public authority or public benefit corporation of the state.

Further the defendant offered such written instrument with the knowledge or belief that it would be filed with, registered or recorded in or would otherwise become a part of the records of such public office, public servant, public authority or public benefit corporation.

To wit: The above named defendant did, upon information and belief, knowingly, intentionally and unlawfully offer and present a written instrument containing false information to employees of the Lake Champlain-Lake George Regional Planning Board, specifically an Invoice from the Lake George Watershed Coalition in the amount of \$69,156.30 further described as Subcontractor Invoices of Natural Restorations by Linda J. & Co, Inc, that the defendant created, knowing such instrument contained such false information and with intent to defraud the Lake Champlain-Lake George Regional Planning Board and the United States Department of Agriculture.

Further the defendant offered such written instrument with the knowledge or belief that it would be filed with, registered or recorded in or would otherwise become a part of the records of Warren County.



In 2012, my company won a landscaping contract bid in Warren County New York for the West Brook Conservation Initiative project. The contract was between the Town of Queensbury and Natural Restorations by Linda J & Co., Inc. The Project No. was 90730.04

I submitted the payment application and certification for these changes on December 21, 2012 to David Decker. On February 12, 2016, Natural Restorations was finally paid the \$21,271.17 for the work change orders by David Decker with check # 1542 from the Lake George Watershed Conference.

Recently, Investigator Conine contacted me and asked if I had submitted an additional invoice to David Decker in the amount of \$69,156.30 for work as part of the West Brook Conservation Initiative. Investigator Conine also emailed me a copy of an invoice which referenced this amount as "Reimbursable Expenses" on Lake George Watershed Coalition letterhead billed to Lake Champlain-Lake George Regional Planning Board. I never submitted an invoice for \$69,156.30 to David Decker at any time. David Decker has never paid me or my company anything more than the above two invoices for \$295,555 and \$21,271.17.
