

BOAT RENTAL SAFETY CHECK LIST

1. Location and use of safety equipment

- a) Throwable Personal Flotation Device (PFD)
- b) Anchor
- c) Fire Extinguisher
- d) PFDs

2. Capacity of boat and how many life jackets are on board



3. Safe distribution of passengers and load on the boat



This Boat Is Overloaded And Unsafe

4. Company policy on use of boats after sunset

5. Proper lookout required

Everyone on boat needs to watch for other vessels, canoes, kayaks and swimmers -- stay 200 feet from private property shore

6. Tubing/skiing requires three

(1) Driver, (2) lookout over 10 years old, and (3) tuber/skier. Everyone tubing or skiing must wear a type 3 PFD

7. Everyone under 12 years old *must wear a PFD at all times* when the boat is under way

8. Zero tolerance for Boating While Intoxicated

9. Buoy Review

10. Lower unit and propeller have been inspected and found to be in good working order

11. Use of:

- a) Steering
- b) Throttle Control
- c) Lanyard
- d) Trim
- e) Blower
- f) Fuel Ports
