# Remote Learning Option

- Remote learning will be an option for the entire 2020-2021 school year upon parent request.
- Once this commitment is made, it cannot be changed.
- A teacher will be designated as your child's teacher for the school year.
- Devices will be available for students.
- Fridays (same schedule as other students)
- Grading
- Google classroom as educational platform

8:30-11:30        Live teaching, video lessons, independent work, brain breaks

12:30-1:00        Lunch

*Fridays – same schedule as in-person schedule*

# What are we doing to help our students transition. . .

- End of August – Welcome letter from teacher
- September 3<sup>rd</sup> – “Live” virtual class meeting to get tour of classroom and meet teacher
- List of Expectations (example bus seats)
- Teach routines and procedures

# Contact Tracing

- We will follow CDC guidelines regarding contact tracing.
- Nurse Sue and School Physician will be the liaison to the Ocean County Department of Health.
- The district will adhere to federal and state requirements regarding privacy.
- CDC Guidelines/Quarantine (Travel/Exposure)
- Note: If a staff member or student tests positive for COVID-19, we will contact the Executive County Superintendent and Ocean County Health Department and follow their direction.
- All staff and parents will be notified if someone tests positive while maintaining confidentiality.

# Parent Meetings

The Restart and Recovery Plan will be presented to parents on Wednesday, July 29<sup>th</sup> at 1pm & 6pm.
